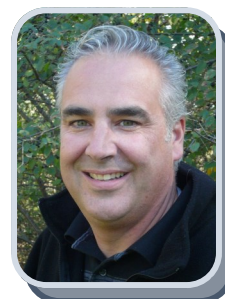

Trustee Meeting Minutes

May 8, 2014

Trustees Present: Ray Calogero, Jeff Dowd, Mike Kahwaty, Kim Good, Dan Schultz and Greg Struble

Meeting Between LFYC & LFNS Board: The LFNS Board is looking to restructure the school so that it works with the current times. They had a board meeting and they have voted in an additional board position that they are calling Executive Chairperson (liaison) for the school. Their goal is to figure out the trend and the needs of the school. They have invited the board or board members from the LFYC to attend their graduation on May 29th at 10:30. They have made a request for the LFYC Board to consider and that would be to forego the June payment since their last week of school will be Week of May 26th. They have asked the LFYC Board when considering next year's contract negotiations, to allow the school to have exclusivity to the playground during the hours that the school is open and in session. The board will take this into consideration and it can be added in contract when that is reviewed for new year.

Boat Races: Discussion ensued with regard to the result of the Boat races here and the damage on the grounds. Ray informed the board that Jay Muller let him know he will be here Monday or Tuesday to do the repairs to the grounds.

Audit: Status has not changed. Still waiting for the auditor to get in touch with Eileen Born. Eileen sent a letter requesting status of audit.

Office: Review of Meeting Minutes for April 10, 2014. Minutes have been approved. Review of New Rentals since last meeting.

Welcome/Membership: Discussion ensued with regard to Senior Memberships. Question asked was could Grandchildren who do not live in LF of Grandparents who are LFYC Members use the membership (swim lessons, beach, etc.). Board agreed that this is acceptable. Discussion ensued with regard to cost of the membership. \$200 for new seniors and any existing senior who pays over \$200 is lowered to \$200. Must be 65 years of age to qualify. Proof is required.

Tennis: The board will honor the request of Bill Nasiuta to have lines painted on the court to play a new game called Pickle ball. This will be done shortly.

Nursery School: Discussion ensued with regard to the meeting with the school's board. Someone from the LFYC Board will attend their graduation and they will decide via email. With regard to the playground

use and rules, Mike will work on the verbiage. Board discussed allowing exclusive rights to the playground between 11am and 3pm. Discussion ensued with regard to letting payment for June be removed.

Expansion Committee: Jeff wants to get the word out to solicit for volunteers to help with this committee. Mike and Greg want to stay on as volunteers.

By Laws: Jeff wants to also ask the members if anyone wants to be on this committee – open invite.

Security: They will be starting on opening day weekend. Question asked was should we end sooner. We could bring them back for Halloween and mischief night. Discussion ensued.

Social: Changing Community Day to June 22nd as there is a rental on the 21st and it's a wedding. Looking into putting in a GAGA pit. The boat course is all set up for Saturday. Discussion ensued with regard to the Polo Kayak Tournament. The board will bring it back to the December meeting to hold it here next year since they have found an alternate place to hold the tournament this year. Question asked was does any board member have any objections to allowing Andy Egan to run a Dart Club? All are in favor but with some stipulations: they clean up afterwards so no cleaning is required, they are in charge of set up and organizing the event. This must be publicized in the Porthole News and email blast. Kim would like to do more to work with Lake Shawnee. Social Committee is working on a Casino night. But no other events have been added for this year.

Beach/Galley: Discussion ensued with regard to a member's request to have extra guards at the swim lanes so member adults and kids can swim there while swim team is not using them. There needs to be at least 1 guard there and they should rotate. There should also be a test for kids to see if they can swim before they are allowed to use the lanes. Kim will talk to Scott Davis about offering lifeguard course here at LF every year. With regard to the Grills on the premises, there is one behind the clubhouse that is in good shape. Considering the two over by the galley, one needs to be replaced as it has holes in the bottom. Mike asked if we could order a couple more round wooden tables for the grounds. All tables need to be stained. The swim curtain is in need of some repairs. It can be used this year as the damage is located where the curtain overlaps. It was cut by the blade of boat motors. May need the repairs next year. Need more wheelbarrows. Dan is looking into getting better equipment to remove the weeds from the swim area.

Discussion ensued with regard to the septic. The float needs to be lowered. Also look into changing the alarm to receive text as warning the levels are high. Greg will take over the task of caring for the Kegurators. Greg will set up a maintenance schedule. Keith Moran likes to handle replacing the CO2 cartridges.



Grand opening for the galley was a wonderful weekend. It was successful and it was nice to see everyone come down. I

met a lot of great people who gave a lot of great suggestions.

Thank you. Feel free to stop down on the weekends. The menu will be a wide range of items. Also there will be weekend specials which I will have posted at the galley. Items include but not limited to hamburger, hot dogs, pizza, fries, walking tacos, grilled cheese, breakfast sandwiches, along with chips and ice cream, and refreshments.



The snack stand will be open On Friday June 20th for the Movie Night. We will also be open every weekend from Noon to 5:00 and will be open full time starting June 23rd with hours Noon to 6:00. Hours could vary on the weekends.

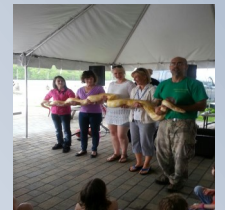
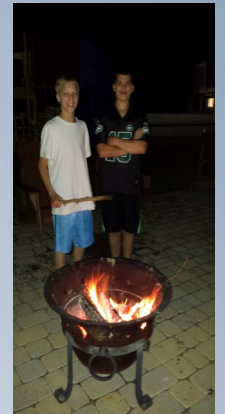

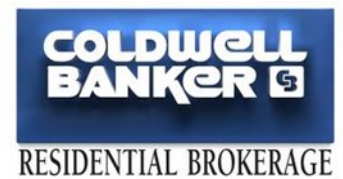
