Aug. 11, 1992

FINANCIAL Estimated budget for '92-'93 was reviewed & accepted. Very little change from '91-'92, with exception of property tax line, and funds needed for dredging, & possible clubhous improvements. Total ex-pected is \$107,000. No dues increase planned.

INSURANCE Coverage and costs were reviewed with additional carriers. Insurance audit will be done before decision is made.

MAINTENANCE Fall Clean-Up Day Sept. 12. Need to take in swim curtain, perform repair to catwalk, not much else because lifeguards & rec. dir. did a lot.

DREDGING Area around diving platform has filled in about 2-3 ft. since '81 dredging. With this year's 5 yr. drawdown of lake this will be performed this fall. Permit ap. and contractor have been contacted.

BEACH Discussion on appropo thanks to lifeguard staff for great job they did this year—Marilyn Agresto will be consulted.

SWIM TEAM Team will ask LFYC members who are on swim team to park in main lot during team functions as courtesy to ensure ready access for B & C dock renters. Team placed 2nd in league for '92 season.






