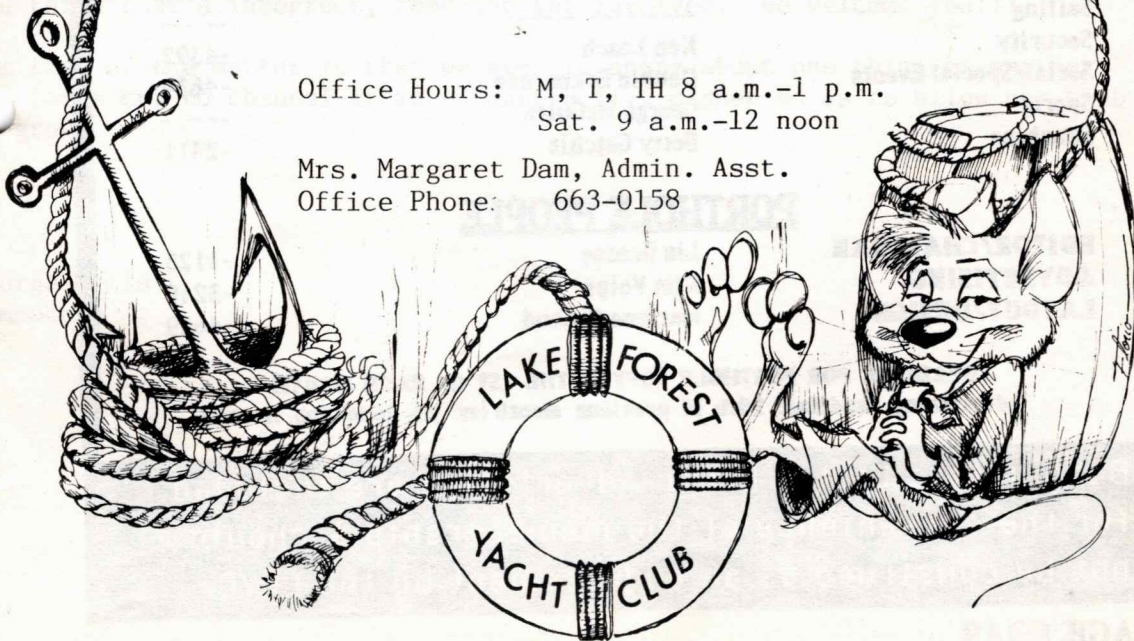

RECREATION AT LAKE FOREST

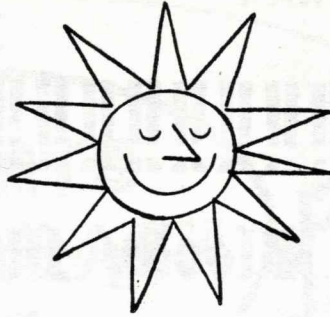
- July 16th Cartoon Night --Walt Disney's favorite characters will be visiting our clubhouse at 7:00 P.M.
