PHIL SCHIFF:

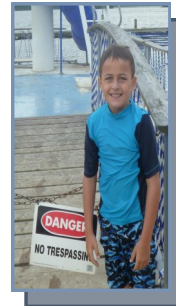
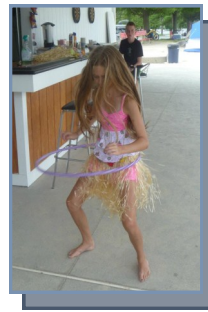
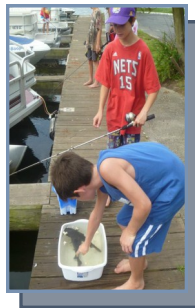
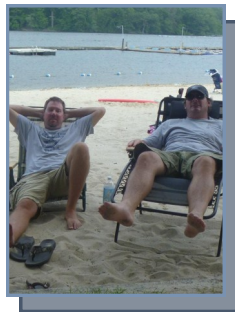
Beach: Discussion ensued regarding the meeting with Courtney prior to the trustee meeting. Further discussion will follow in the next few meetings with regards to the following year.

ANDY EGAN:

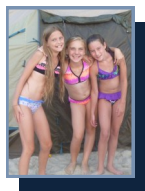
Swim Team: One of the tasks our maintenance person has on his list is the security cameras and finishing the installation.
