Commodore's Message

Summer is always the busiest time for us at our club with activities going on at the beach and at our boat docks. This trustee board has made it a priority to improve the experience for members at our beach this summer and I'd like to detail for you operations and club enhancements we've been working on for you.



We are making every effort to maintain the quality of our swim area. We're controlling the weeds with our swim curtains and daily beach clean-up. We've already had the Lake Hopatcong Commission weed harvester come in and remove weed growth and plan to have them come in again later this season. We also had aquatic herbicide applied this season to control new weed growth.

Garden State Labs tests our beach area water every week to confirm compliance with DEP standards for swimming. You'll find the weekly report posted at our office bulletin board as well as at the beach galley. If the report confirms results above the acceptable DEP standards, we restrict water access and proceed with procedures to remedy the problem. This was the case on June 22nd and 23rd when we posted signs "Beach Closed, No Swimming" to protect our members.

Would you like to have a barbeque at the beach this summer? We have two propane grills available at our beach galley for members use. Any adult member, 18 or over, may use the grill and borrow one of our propane tanks. Give our beach director your beach badge and she'll give you the propane tank. Clean the grill afterwards and return the propane tank to our beach director.

We also have three new octagon shaped, 8 person picnic table on order for our new paver patio. Members have use of those tables anytime during the season, except during a clubhouse rental as use of the patio is part of the rental.

The dubhouse is closed for renovations this month. During the month of July, if you would like to rent our new paver patio for a private function, it is available for \$75.00. You'll have exclusive use of the patio, access to the Commodore Room kitchen and restrooms as well as our club tables and chairs. If your event could be conducted outdoors, rain or shine, the patio would be perfectly suited. Contact the club office to arrange the patio rental.

The weekend of July 21st and 22nd is our "Lake Forest Yacht Club Open House". On this weekend, we are amending our member only policy by making our facility available to all Lake Forest residents. In lieu of a member badge, this mailed July Porthole will be your pass for the weekend at our club facility. Enjoy our beach, have a snack at our concession stand, check out our tennis or basketball court and socialize with your neighbors. We've made many improvements at our club and there is more to come. See what you've been missing and join the club and enjoy our year round social events.

Have an enjoyable Independence Day holiday, and I'll see you on the beach.

Lake Forest Facilities Update by Frank Gutowski

Because of Jim Brown's work used toward exterior painting repair. I'd like to thank Greg scheduled this month, he asked my help to provide this month's club facility update. We have been very busy on multiple projects and repairs so that members can take full advantage of club activities. Our beach is now fully open for the season with lifeguards on duty daily and we have many activities planned.

Dock Slip Rentals:

We are completely sold out. This year we had 57 member rentals and 20 non-member rentals. The share of nonmember rentals this season is slightly higher than what we had forecasted in our 2007 budget. A benefit to us is that we have generated some additional funds which we are putting back into the club. This additional revenue is being

of the clubhouse and commodore room.

Beach Repairs in June:

Our yellow slide used in our swim area had two broken steps. We took the slide for repair to Jul-Mel welding in Prospect Point and had not only the broken steps repaired. but also all the steps and welds reinforced. I'd like to thank Bill Good (no relation to Greg Good) of Jul-Mel for expediting the repair so that our young members were able to use the repaired slide by the weekend.

We also had to close the dive tower due to broken steps on both of our lower ladders. We ordered new steps and had our lifeguards install them on the ladders. We also had to reanchor the installation bolts which broke off due to the Orlikowski for ordering us the new ladder steps and expediting delivery as well as Paul Sabia for reinstalling the ladder bolts to the dive tower.

Beach Concessions:

Our Beach Concession Stand is now open daily from 12 to 3 PM. We have plenty of beverages, snacks and ice cream available for all members to enjoy. Stop by and check out the new menu items next time your at the beach. You'll also notice we have a new soda machine at the beach galley. The old machine was in bad shape, so the vendor dropped off a newer version. We believe the new machine will be more reliable.

Swim Lessons:

Swim lessons are once again starting at the beach with Amanda DeSantis as our swim lesson instructor. Details on swim lessons are in this months Porthole.

Parking Permits and Beach

This year we have new blue beach badges and blue dated stickers for your parking tags. Please make sure you update your parking tag with the new sticker and that you have your 2007 beach badges whenever using the club facilities. Our beach operations staff and security guard will be requesting badges for any members and guests using the club including the beach and basketball courts.

new paver patio. They are sturdy wooden tables with attached benches that will seat 8 people. The tables were acquired with the proceeds we received from members who purchased the engraved stones we installed on our patio. They are available for member use anytime except when the clubhouse or patio is rented for a private function.

If you are interested in having an engraved stone installed in the patio, we will be doing a second run of engraved stones toward the end of the summer. Cost is \$40 per stone and you can pick up an order form from the club office or on our website.

Clubhouse Paver Patio Rentals

During the month of July, we are making our new clubhouse patio available for party rentals. This is only for the month of July, as we have the clubhouse closed for renovation. Members may rent the patio for \$75, and will have access to the Commodore Room bathrooms as well as the clubhouse tables and chairs. After the clubhouse renovation is complete, the patio area will once again be part of the clubhouse rental.

Cigarette Butt Receptacles

We have placed a cigarette

butt receptacle at our beach galley as well as one at the fence near the clubhouse. Please utilize these receptacles for disposing your cigarette butts whenever smoking outdoors at our facility. Remember, there is no smoking inside the clubhouse.

Clubhouse Exterior Painting Project:

Due in part to the additional revenue from non-member dock slips, we are going forward with painting the exterior of our clubhouse in July. In addition to the painting, some minor repair will also be done to the wood siding. I'm sure all of you will agree that the clubhouse is in desperate need of an exterior paint job. I'm pleased we have the additional funds to make it happen and improve the appearance of our club.

Tennis Lessons:

Tennis Lessons are back at the club. This year we have a new tennis instructor, loe Fennell who is the head coach of the Sparta High School Tennis Team. He will be providing three, I hour sessions each Tuesday and Thursday evening for six weeks starting on July 10th. Two sessions for children and the third for adults. Member cost for the 12 lessons is \$75. Class size is limited and available only to LFYC members. (See page 14 for complete details)

Lake Forest Swim Team






The much anticipated Horseshoe tournament also brought \$50 prizes to the winning team of Fred Stewart and John Postal.




