



# Commodore's Message

Wow... that is the earliest we've ever sold out an event! Who's the comedians? I hear we have a waiting list if the social committee can figure a way to fit another table in there for the event.



I have more great news in that we have another new trustee on the board. Paul Sabia has been chosen by the board to fulfill the remainder of Peter Maniscalco's trustee term. Paul has been very active in volunteering on many club projects and participating in our social events, so we know he will be an excellent contributor with the current board. Welcome to the board Paul.

Of a more serious note, back in October 2005 we discovered that our previous office manager had embezzled over \$10,000 from our club. She had deceived us all by taking the funds before resigning and relocating with her family to North Carolina. Because she was in North Carolina, many in our community felt we would never be able to have her arrested, brought back to NJ or receive restitution for the stolen funds. We on the board never gave up as we let the legal processes go forward. Well, I have an update for membership: The authorities got her!

Our previous office manager was arrested by North Carolina authorities on December 22<sup>nd</sup> 2006 and remained incarcerated waiting extradition back to N.J through mid-January. Chuck Emery and I attended her arraignment hearing at the Morris County Courthouse in late January, where in front of the judge, she pled guilty to the theft and criminal charges against her. She posted bond and she will be back to court for her sentencing hearing in March.

In addition to gaining a criminal record, she will have to pay restitution in full for the stolen funds, \$4,000 of which we collected at the arraignment hearing. Details of her restitution payments to the club will be decided by the judge at her upcoming sentencing hearing. We are well on our way to putting this dark chapter of LFYC history behind us and we will receive back all the stolen funds.

So, we have lots of good things happening at our club. Have a Happy St Patrick's Day and I'll see you at the Beefsteak Comedy Night.

# Lake Forest Facilities Update by Jim Brown

With the arrival of winter the past month, can spring be far behind? Regardless of the weather, the trustees have been diligent in moving several projects forward. Here is a brief update on the facilities and the projects.

# **New Patio**

In the spring, and before the opening festivities, the grassy area between the clubhouse and lake, a paver patio will be installed, with the LFYC logo inlayed in the center. The work will begin in May. I hope you take advantage of the opportunity and buy a personalized engraved paver for your family. This project will enhance the appearance of the club, and make the patio area more functional for our mem-

bers, and guests.

# Clubhouse Repair

Former Commodore Fred Stewart is taking the lead on this project. If you see him looking stressed, tell him he's doing a great job! Because this is a big investment, an architect will be hired to ensure that it gets done correctly. Remember the clubhouse will not be available for the month of July.

# Kitchen Closet

Bob Luongo has been doing a great job completing a punch list of small to medium sizes jobs in and around the club. Among the recently completed jobs is the closet in the kitchen, which needed some attention. Insulation was installed to cover the hole left when the old heating and air conditioning system was removed, storage shelves

were installed, and a tool holder installed.

# **Oven Fan**

Thanks to Tony Maciorski the venting fan above the oven is now wired correctly, and in good working order.

# **Panic Door**

Pat Brennan has ordered a new set of doors and scheduled the installation. With Jim Thompson. The need for the new panic doors is to insure meeting fire safety codes.

# Wi-Fi Hot Spot

Pat is gathering information and pricing on making wireless Internet access available on the club property.

# Parking Permit and Beach Tags

# New Gate Arm and Card Reader

2/8/07: Meeting called to order, 7:05pm

# **Trustees present:**

# **Trustee Updates**

# Pat:

Discussion over making the Yacht Club properties a Wi-Fi Hot Spot. Pat Brennan to pursue pricing for implementation in the summer.

# Jim:

Bob Luongo Update: Closet organization. Finished. Advertisement for new Life Guards will begin in the lanuary Porthole. Iim to also post in the Sussex YMCA and the West Morris YMCA. Discussion on hiring a Concession Stand Operator to "man" the stand decided it would be the responsibility of the Beach Director and Assistant Beach Director to delegate concession staffing. lim to continue work on Beach Directors and Assistant Beach Director job description. Swim Team update: Chris the assistant coach may not be returning.

# Chris:

Chris suggested hosting a Carnival at the Yacht Club. After further review and an informal polling, decided to not pursue the initiative. Chris offered to review rental rates for similar halls in the area and provide a report in a future Trustee meeting. (VFW's renting from \$300 + \$50 as deposit).

New gate arm is still required for the gate Chris to pursue with Baxter Associates. Discussion ensued, decision to replace card reader, gate arm and obtain replacement cards. Motion by Chris to have the reader replaced and 500 replacement cards seconded by Chuck, unanimous approval. Badge update. Decision to upgrade our badges so that they don't peel. Minor increase in price, decision to move forward.

# Chuck:

Our lawyer sent us a correspondence regarding the taxation of membership dues, Trenton has yet to make a firm stance on this change there is a possibility that we will be charged sales tax for membership dues. If true retroactive tax will be paid by the Club, afterwards tax will be collected from the membership. Awaiting direction/clarification from Trenton. IRS Audit scheduled for February 20th.

# Frank:

Fred Stewart recommended we engage an architect for their recommendations on the club. Motion by Frank to engage an architect, seconded by Chris, all in favor. Patio Paver Project: Notice to go into the Porthole to pay for engraved bricks. Received 2 member referrals for seal coatings.

Discussion about open Trustee

John Malone presented to the board a concept for the paver patio including engraving of bricks, he shared prices from Grinnel etc. John willing to assist. Motion by Frank to include engraved bricks in the Patio paver project, seconded by Chuck, all in favor.

Helene Emery, Cindy Maniscalco and Laura D'Uva presented their recommendations of the Lake Forest Yacht Club Scholarship Committee (this committee also included Janice Mishkin and Kristi Brown).

Helene suggested having an Open House at the Yacht Club for Master Lease Holders, along with members. Trustees will take it under advisement.

Security expense will go up this year due to legislature passed in the State of New Jersey.

Discussion about putting a light on or near the dive mast so that we may light the flag. Feasibility study to be undertaken by Frank and Tony.





# Lake Forest Yacht Club Clubhouse Patio Project "Commemorative Stone Offer" by Frank Gutowski



This May, excavation work will be taking place on the grassy area behind the clubhouse. We will be removing the grass and installing a paver patio in its place. The color and pattern of the paver patio will be exactly the same as we used for our new clubhouse walkway and in the center will be a 6 to 8 foot wide engraving of our club logo. This will improve the appearance of that area and make it more functional for our club activities. The project will begin in mid May and be completed in advance of our Opening Day Picnic.

John Malone recommended to the board that we offer members the opportunity to purchase an engraved commemorative paver stone. We feel this is an excellent idea, so we are making this available to all current and former LFYC members. We have only a limited time to have the engraved stones produced in advance of the project, for there is a 4 to 6 week lead time, so we need to place the order on April 1<sup>st</sup> to assure they arrive in time for the patio build.

All current or former members may purchase a 6" x 9" Commemorative Engraved Stone (similar to the sample shown) engraved with a message for only \$35.00 (pre-construction price). Your message may be up to 3 lines, with each line having a maximum of 13 characters. Commemorative Engraved Stone order forms are available in the March Porthole, the club office or may be downloaded from our website: www.lfyc.org. Please fill out the order form, make out a payment of \$35 to the LFYC and mail or deliver both to the LFYC office by March 31st, 2007.

After that date we will still take orders for members wanting to have an engraved stone installed after patio construction. Our contractor will come back and pull out installed stones and replace it with the engraved stones. The cost for the engraved stone will be higher than \$35 for there will be additional labor fees. Details will be provided at a later date.

This is an opportunity for you to be part of this patio project and to commemorate your time here at Lake Forest. Please get your order in before the deadline of March 31st 2007 to ensure you get the pre-construction price.


