Application deadline is April 16, 2015!

The deadline for LFYC Scholarship applications is fast approaching as the deadline is April 16th. If you are planning to apply for this scholarship, please make sure your application is postmarked by that date so that it may be considered by the LFYC Scholarship Committee.

The scholarship will award \$1,000 to help start off an applicant's higher education endeavor. This one time award may be used for tuition, books and other school related expenses. The candidate must be a Lake Forest Yacht Club member in good standing as well as a 2015 graduating high school senior. Complete details of the application criteria will be found on the LFYC Scholarship.

Scholarship applications should be addressed to the LFYC Scholarship Committee and be mailed to the LFYC with a postage date no later than April 16th, 2015. The five members of the 2015 LFYC Scholarship Committee will evaluate all applications and make a decision on who will be the recipient of the 2015 LFYC Scholarship. The recipient will be notified on or before May 31st, 2015.

Boat Safety Course

April 11, 2015 from 8:00am to 5:00pm

Registration is Required \$65 Members/\$75 Non-Members

Boating Safety First is a Morris County based service provider dedicated to conducting boating safety courses for the recreational boating public in the Lake Hopatcong and Lake Mohawk area. Our course is approved by the National Association of State Boating Law Administrators (NASBLA) and the New Jersey State Police Marine Services Bureau (MSB).

This course is approved by NASBLA and the New Jersey State Police MSB and provides the necessary education for a recreational boater to obtain the mandatory New Jersey Boating Safety Certificate (NJ BSC) to legally operate a power boat or Personal Watercraft on New Jersey inland waters. Boat New Jersey is an 8 hour course, including the final exam. Preregistration is encouraged to confirm enrollment and a seat. Boat New Jersey consists of six lessons; Know Your Boat, Before You Get Underway, Operating Your Boat Safely, Legal Requirements of Boating, Boating Emergencies and Enjoying Water Sports. Each lesson is followed by review questions to reinforce the course information presented and enhance the students learning experience.

All of our courses are conducted by highly experienced Boat Instructors, who have undergone extensive training to become New Jersey State qualified instructors. All of our Instructors are New Jersey State Police certified Boat Instructors. These individuals are experienced boaters.

Trustee Meeting Minutes

March 12, 2015

Trustees Present: Ray Calogero, Dan Schultz, Greg Struble, Jon Schiedlo Sr., Keith Moran, Anna Carrion and Mike Kahwaty

Beach/Galley: Keith let the board know that the ad for the open lifeguard positions was placed in the Porthole News. He would like to put an ad in to find someone to hire as a beach director. A request was made to review the description or list of duties/responsibilities for this position.

By-Laws: Greg presented the board members with the changes he would like to present to the members for a vote. Discussion ensued.

Communications: Discussion ensued with regard to updating/ changing the website. Anna let the board know that Tony recommended we use Go-Daddy to help us build our own site that is user friendly and one which the board can operate easily.

Docks: Ray let the board know he ordered the wood for the catwalk project. Walt from AAA Docks helped Ray with the ice eaters and he suggested that they be moved so they can cover more area. Walt has someone he can recommend to provide us with a proposal on the A Dock Project. The board decided to begin the catwalk project on March 28th, 29th and April 4th from 7am to 2pm.

Grounds/Maintenance: Ray let the board know that he spoke to the land-scaper. He will work on a more formal contract to be reviewed and signed each year.

LFNS: Mike has made efforts to reach out to Laura to find out what the status is on the school restructuring and opening in the fall. She has responded to him letting him know that they are still proceeding with reorganizing the school.

LFST: Ray let the board know that he had a discussion with their president about the 2015 contract.

Office: A question arose with regard to the hourly rental contract. A correction will be made to state that the member who rented by the hour will have the right to pay for a full day rental if another member makes a request for a full day rental for the same day.

Security: Mike asked for a copy of the agreement from last year. He will review it and get one from Al Rossy for this upcoming season. Discussion ensued with regard to trespassers on the property.

Welcome/Membership: A request was made to provide the trustees with a list of new residents for them to introduce themselves, etc.
