New NJ Boating Regulation Takes Effect June 1st

As the state's crowded waterways gave rise to more accidents and close calls, lawmakers decided to make safety education mandatory for nearly all recreational boaters. A new law that takes effect in June will require anyone who operates a power vessel to take an eight-hour safety course and pass a test to prove that they know the rules of the water. Experienced boaters will be given a one-time chance to pass a written test that will exempt them from the course. If they fail, they have to take the course. (Continued on page 10)


Goose Control for the Upcoming Season

The goose feces problem at the beach and grassy areas continue to be a problem for us and some of the efforts we have tried in the past have been ineffective. While my recommended solution of fencing some of our areas to prevent the geese from coming in from the lake has not received strong support from the membership, I have not given up the battle to reclaim our facility from the geese.

This season we will try a new product called Goose Stopper which will be sprayed on the grassy areas and dock areas. The spray is not a chemical but rather a combination of natural products that the geese hate the taste of and the feel of when they walk on treated areas. The application will be sprayed once every three weeks. We will purchase a 5 gallon concentrate which we believe will give us 3 to 4 months of treatment. We will start the first application in April and see how it performs.

Spring Beach Clean-up: April 29th

Please mark April 29th on your calendar for our annual Spring Beach Clean-up (with a rain date of April 30th). As usually we will have many projects that will need to be tended to in order to prepare our club for the 2006 season. In addition to the installation of the catwalks, swim curtains and diving platforms, we'll also have some minor repairs and painting that will need to be done. We'll need a large turnout of members to help with the cleanup, so please come down and help us get the club ready for the summer. Of course we will provide coffee, doughnuts and bagels in the morning and pizza and beverages for lunch. In the April Porthole, I'll provide complete details as to the projects for Beach Clean-up Day.



2006 Season Dock Rentals: Deadline 3/15/06

As we get closer to the start of the boating season, we want to remind all members who rented slips in 2005 that the March 15th dock slip renewal deadline is approaching. We expect to be sold out again this year for we already have six new member dock slip rental requests and about a dozen non-members who want to rent a slip from us this season.

The 2006 dock rental fee for members is \$410.00. To renew for the 2006 season, please return the completed and signed rental agreement along with a copy of your boat registration and payment by March 15th 2006. Also, please indicate if there is any repair issue that needs to be tended to regarding your slip.

If you have no intention to renew your dock slip for the 2006 season, please contact the LFYC office so that we may reassign the slip to another member.

After March 18th, we will assign the new member rental slips and open up available slips to members who want to rent a 2nd slip.

On April 1st, all remaining open dock slips will be made available to non-members at a rental fee of \$1,000.

New NJ Boating Regs

The law, which former Gov. Richard Codey signed in January, staggers compliance over the next three years. Boaters born in 1969 or later will need to be certified first, by June 1.

The new law does not apply to commercial boaters because they already take tests to obtain their licenses. It also does not apply to out-of state boaters 18 and older who operate a vessel for fewer than 30 days in New Jersey if they can show proof of similar education from the National Association of State Boating Law Administrators, the U.S. Coast Guard, or another state.

Under the new law, those born after Dec. 31, 1968, will have to take the eight-hour course immediately to be in compliance by June I. Those born between Dec. 31, 1958, and Dec. 31, 1968, will have until June I, 2007, to take the course, and those born between Dec. 31, 1948, and Dec. 31, 1958, will have until June I, 2008. All others will have to take the course before June I, 2009.

The New Jersey State Police, who will administer the tests, have not yet determined the definition of "experienced" or what will be included on the test. The new regulations also require owners of personal watercraft to complete the educational course before operating the machine. (Information sourced from Star Ledger article on nj.com)


