

MINUTES OF TRUSTEES MEETING JANUARY 9, 1990

(This is a synopsized version. Complete minutes available at the LFYC Office.) **FEES** A schedule of fees payable when joining the LFYC will be published in the Porthole. After discussion, it was decided to keep the billing dates as they are. All current bills must be up-to-date as of 2/15/90 in order to reserve dock space.

BOND MONEY After discussion, the bond payment system will remain as is.

SECURITY The Security Committee has been renamed Safety. However, Security will continue to be listed in the Porthole's Ready Reference with the Jeff. Twp. Police Dept. phone number. They should be called in the event of an emergency or if there are trespassers on Club property.

GALLEY An item will be placed in the Porthole asking if anyone is interested in running the galley this year. A suggestion was made that members would purchase coupons at the beginning of the season for use at the galley. Coupons not used would not be refundable. Another suggestion was to install vending machines.

INSURANCE An agent will be contacting Margaret for more information regarding Directors and Officers liability insurance. The cost may be approx. \$500-\$1500.

TENNIS The tennis party has been scheduled for Feb. 17, 1990.




