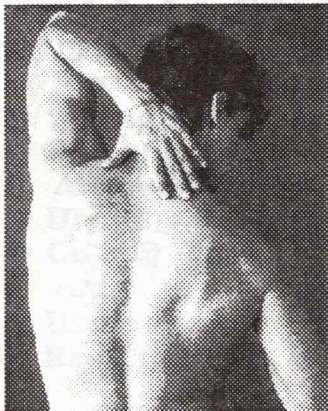

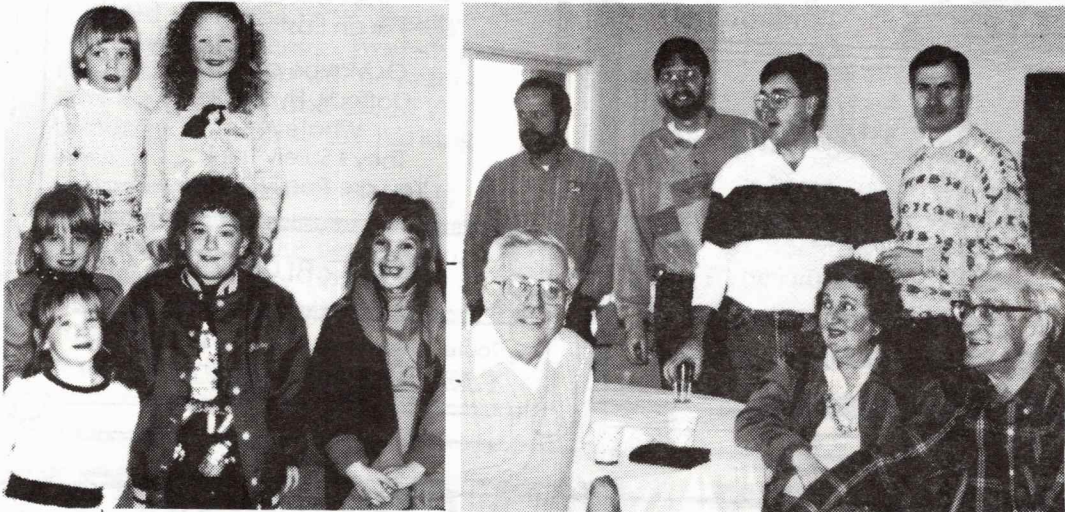

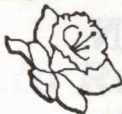

LFYC TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

February 12, 1991

(Minutes are synopsisized, For a complete copy, please see Margaret at the LFYC office.)

PROPERTY TAXES The appraisal firm rejected our bid for reevaluation so we must now contest the evaluation with the county and township.

INSURANCE Reviewed and upgraded all points from last inspection except alarm system. Now looking into alarm system.

CLUBHOUSE Edges of floor in the main room are breaking up and holes are forming. Will fill in holes and retile edges. Parks Roofing have been notified about new area of loose shingles, but have not responded yet.

BEACH Reviewed rules for beach which Paul Murray will reorganize. Greg Plifka will write rules and regulations regarding new swim lane area. Both Jen Hill ('90 Recreation Director) and Jen Bruce (lifeguard) are interested in returning this summer. Trustees will review their salaries and possible linking with swim team.

BUDGET Since we are unsure of the outcome of the property tax petition we will need to reserve more of the budget. Greg will contact JCP&L about getting energy audit of our facilities to help understand costs of our usage.

DOCKS Member dock rentals are very low at this point— deadline for members renewals is Feb. 15. Previous leasees will be contacted about renewal. Docks unrented to members will be available to persons living outside of reservation after Feb. 15. Margaret will take inquiries.

SWIM TEAM Plans for swim lanes and starting platform at outer end of peninsula were presented. Plans include using seven posts to anchor 2-tiered deck along end of peninsula and floating platform. Swim lanes run parallel to catwalk. Unanimous approval of plans.

WATER QUALITY Allied Biological representative will attend March 12 meeting to discuss weed problems, especially in lagoon and swim area.

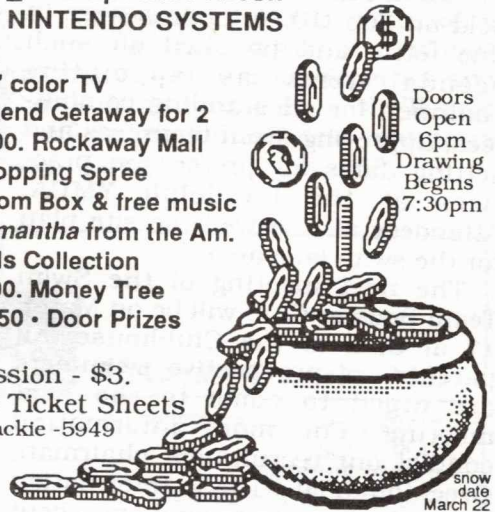

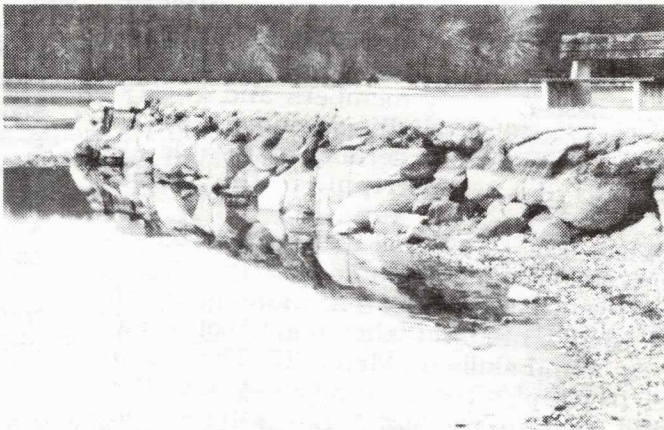

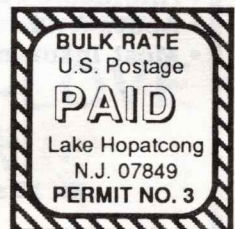
