LFYC TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

October 12, 1993

(The following minutes are synopsisized. See Margaret at the LFYC office for a complete set.)

MASTER LEASE Reviewed progress of collection of delinquent Master Lease accounts. In most recent batch most have paid in full or have set up payment schedule, remainder have been sent to Club attorney for collection, including placement of liens which are "personal obligation" liens, thereby affecting all property owned by the Lake Forest lessee.

ANNUAL MEETING DATE SET FOR FRIDAY, DEC. 3 AT 8 PM. NOTICES WILL INCLUDE REQUEST FOR BY-LAWS CHANGE.

TRUSTEE NOMINEES Nominating committee has submitted following as nominees for election to Bd. of Trustees: Glenn DeSantis, Robert Drummond, Gary Gamble and Eric Gorzelnik. (Stan Bandura had also been nominated, but by press time found a scheduling conflict forced him to withdraw his name from nomination.) Discussion by nominating committee and question to Trustees on number of candidates for each slot. Trustees concluded that number should be at minimum the same number as vacated positions, but up to discretion of committee how many to seek beyond the minimum.

RENOVATION Floor ready to be laid. New cabinets, counters, refrigerator, dishwasher waiting in wings. More information being sought on status of stove.

TENNIS COURT Estimates for new surfaces for basketball and tennis court to submitted next mtg, tennis court lighting to be considered with estimates. Drinking fountain not to be considered.

GALLEY Awaiting estimates on patio roof, gutters, beam in lifeguard room, concrete floor.

BEACH Report that supplier would not sell slide to be installed in the shallow water we had intended; to put in deeper water would preclude younger swimmer's use. Slide purchase tabled.

INSURANCE Agent answered Trustees questions in writing. After review of response Trustees concluded present coverage is enough.

MAINTENANCE Parking lot light's timers adjusted, Chair glides to be replaced to thwart damage to new floor. Swing set center leg to be reset in concrete.

DOCKS All boats must be out of docks and area by Nov. 15
