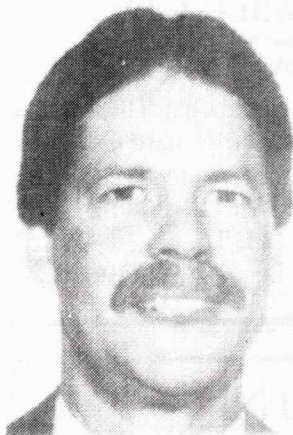
BOB LUONGO

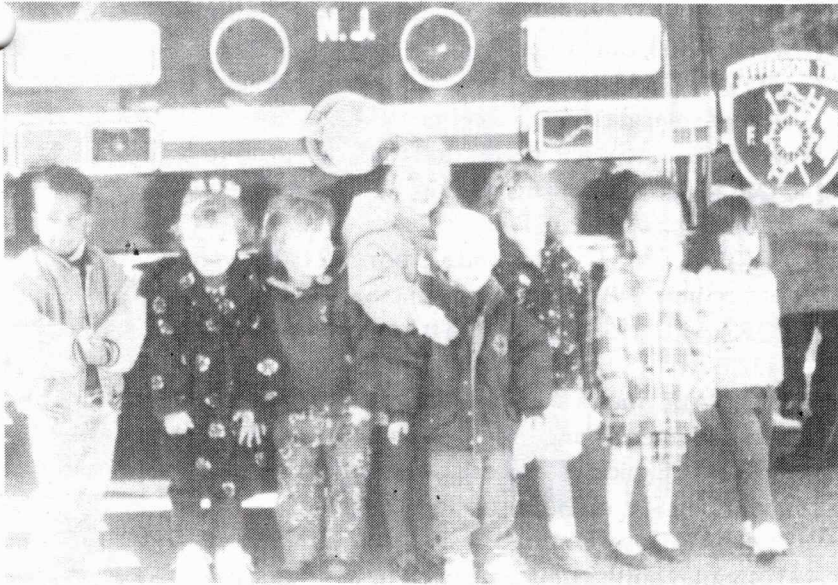
CRAIG PETERS
