Holiday entertaining presents the perfect opportunity to impress family and friends with festive party mixes.

1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1 cup Sun-Maid Raisins

3/4 cup coarsely chopped dried apples

1 cup Diamond Walnut pieces

In medium bowl, combine cinnamon and nutmeg. Add raisins and apples; toss to coat with spices. Add walnuts; toss. Store in airtight container.

WORLD'S GREATEST FUDGE

A wonderful, buttery-rich fudge. Before beating, be sure that this candy cools completely.

2 cups sugar

6 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder

3/4 cup water

1/2 cup butter

1 teaspoon vanilla

1 cup coarsely chopped Diamond Walnuts

In large heavy saucepan, combine sugar, cocoa and water. Cook over medium heat, stirring until sugar is dissolved. Cover and cook over medium-low heat 5 minutes. Add butter. Cook, uncovered and without stirring, over medium heat until 234°F registers on candy thermometer (soft-ball stage). Remove from heat. Without scraping the sides of the saucepan, pour into a clean, dry large bowl. Let stand until completely cooled. Add vanilla and beat until candy loses its gloss. Quickly stir in walnuts; spread into buttered 8-inch square pan. Cut into squares when set.

Makes about 13/4 pounds

ADOPTED November 11, 1983

Section 4 -

The name of this organization shall be the Lake Forest Yacht Club: here-inafter referred to as the Club in these By-Laws. Its principal office and mailing address shall be Lake Forest Yacht Club, R.D. #1, PO Box 217, Lake Forest, Lake Hopatcong, New Jersey 07849.

Section 2 -

The club is incorporated as a non-profit organization.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The purposes for which this Club is formed are:

- A. To acquire, hold administer, maintain, enlarge, improve and otherwise opeate recreational and related facilities and property both real and personal.
- B. To formulate rules and regulations and provide for the enforcement thereof, for the use of all Club properties and facilities now owned or leased and hereafter acquired.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP -

Membership in the Club shall be limited to natural persons and shall be of two classes: Voting Membership and Non-Voting Membership. Each class of membership shall be a household membership. A household shall be deemed to include those persons living together as one household.

- A. Voting Membership shall be limited to owners of real estate in the Lake Forest Reservation who shall also be bondholders.
 - B. Non-Voting Membership shall be limited to:
 - onwers of real estate in Lake Forest Reservation who are not bondholders, and
 - tenants of real estate in the Lake Forest Reservation irrespective of the membership status of the owner of the property
- C. Membership of either class is not transferable or assignable without the consent of the Club Trustees.
- D. The Club's Administrative Assistant or other designated employee shall maintain a list or other records of those real properties which are located within the Lake Forest Reservation.

Section 2 APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP -

Application for membership shall be made to the Board of Trustees by qualified persons. Appropriate application forms for this purpose shall be prescribed by the Trustees.

Section 3 RIGHTS OF MEMBERS -

A. Only voting Members in good standing shall have the rights to vote and hold office.


LAKE FOREST YACHT CLUB SWIM TEAM


