TENNIS COURT RULES

The tennis court is intended for the use of all members of LFYC, however, in order to accommodate all members, the following regulations will apply:

· Open tennis time will be 1 hour of play, on

the hour; i.e. 8 am - 9 am, 9 am - 10 am

• Time may be reserved by signing on the reservation sheet at the club office (posted on the office wall to the left of the door), up to 5 days in advance. Only members in good standing may make reservations or play on the court.

• If the court is not used by ten minutes into the reserved hour it then becomes "open court", first come-first served. No two players may play continuously for 2 reserved hours, although, one player may play with a different player for 2 successive hours.

 All members must wear their LFYC badges when playing on court, their guests must wear guest badges. NO EXCEPTIONS.

 Any LFYC tournament held at LFYC will take precedence over all other play. Tournament time may be scheduled for 2 hours of play before 10 am Saturday and Sunday.


