TENNIS COURT RULES

The tennis court is intended for the use of all members of LFYC, however, in order to accommodate all members, the following regulations will apply:

- Open tennis time will be 1 hour of play, on

the hour; i.e. 8 am - 9 am, 9 am - 10 am

- Time may be reserved by signing on the reservation sheet at the club office (posted on the office wall to the left of the door), up to 5 days in advance. Only members in good standing may make reservations or play on the court.

- If the court is not used by ten minutes into the reserved hour it then becomes "open court", first come-first served. No two players may play continuously for 2 reserved hours, although, one player may play with a different player for 2 successive hours.

- All members must wear their LFYC badges when playing on court, their guests must wear guest badges. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- Any LFYC tournament held at LFYC will take precedence over all other play. Tournament time may be scheduled for 2 hours of play before 10 am Saturday and Sunday.
