### MINUTES OF TRUSTEES MEETING APRIL 10, 1990

(This is a synopsized version. Complete minutes are available at the LFYC office)

**HOUSE** The water leak at the meter has been repaired. The problem was with the meter and therefore the township's financial responsibility.

**BEACH** Diane Faruolo will order crafts for the Children's Summer Crafts program. The program will continue with the cost to remain at \$1 per craft, as it was last year.

A bus trip is being planned for the July 21 evening game of theMets vs. Atlanta. The bus will leave from LFYC. The price will include bus transportation and game ticket. Tickets will be sold on a prepaid, first come-first served basis.

**SIGN** The entrance gate sign has been completed and picked up. Total cost was \$646.60.

It is in the office and will have to be installed.

**ROOF** The roof has been under repair. Missing shingles have been replaced and are being resealed. Margaret will call the roofer and see if the job has been completed. **DOCKS** There are 18 open dock spaces. After much discussion, a motion was made that an attempt should be made to rent the available docks at a rate that would be 85% of an average of 3 marinas: Smitty's, Woodport and Flash. Access will be limited to dock, launching ramp and parking. This option will only be available to non-Lake Forest residents because Lake Forest residents have the opportunity to join and enjoy the club including the docks. The motion carried.

**CLUBHOUSE** It is felt that a test for asbestos fibers in the clubhouse is not warranted at this time. However, the Trustees have been told that buffing the floors does release asbestos fibers into the air, where they will remain for some time. It is recommended that the floors no longer be buffed but wet mopped and a self polishing wax be applied. The alternative to this would be to cover the existing floor. Margaret will inform Everlasting Shine that the floors should be maintained as recommended.

**GALLEY** One person is interested in running the galley this year. They will be called and asked to come down and inspect the galley and see whatwill be needed to get started **NURSERY SCHOOL** Nursery School has been paying rent to Club for use of the Clubhouse. The Board would like to set a fair rent for next year. This will be discussed

with the Nursery School Executive Board.

**BUDGET** The cost of propane rose this year due to the cold snap in December. This extra amount was not provided for in the budget. The money will have to come from some other budgeted area. It should also be noted that along with the shortfall from unrented docks, the membership is not increasing. These two factors have decreased the amount of income that was expected. The most costly part of the year is about to begin; lifeguards, security, recreation director, grass maintenance, etc.

**SOCIAL** Margie Mills has offered to chair a square dance this summer. A suggestion was made to invite Lake Shawnee to co-sponsor. It is scheduled for July 14.

**RECREATION** The annual Fun Run will be held again this yearon June 10.

**SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING** The Semi-Annual Meeting is scheduled for May 18. The quorum necessary this year is 10% of the total voting membership. The required waiting time before the meeting can start has been reduced to 15 minutes. Both changes went into effect with December, 1989 by-laws changes.

<u>CLEAN-UP DAY</u> Clean-Up Day is scheduled for May 19. The list of things to do is being compiled by Joe. Margaret asked that the clubhouse kitchen be included and that the cabinets be cleaned out. There have been complaints of ants and the food in the cabinets may be part of the problem

### RECYCLE...The Yard You Save May Be Your Own

Recently the DAILY RECORD RAN a guide on recycling as part of their Earth Day series. We reprint it here in part.

The average American family of four generates 100 pounds of rubbish every week. Some studies suggest that as much as 84% of the waste stream can be recycled. Japan recycles 50% of its trash, while the United States recycles only 11% and New Jersey, about 25%. An aluminum can thrown away today still will be here 500 years from now and a glass soda bottle will last 2,500 years longer than that.

There are many ways to help, but the best way to reduce trash is to produce less of it: many appliances and building supplies

#### PACKAGING

Avoid needless packaging

- · Buy products in recyclable packages and containers
- · Buy in bulk to cut down on packaging
- · Let manufacturers know your feelings about overpackaging

#### RECYCLING

- Recycle everything you can and encourage local officials to expand recycling programs
- Remind your employer that office paper, computer paper and corrugated cardboard must be recycled
- Compost wet household trash and yard waste
- Reuse containers and plastic bags
- · Use grocery bags more than once or purchase reusable bags
- · Reuse wrapping paper when possible
- · Car batteries, tires, used motor oil,

#### can be recycled DISPOSABLES

 Do not purchase disposable products, such as razors, lighters, etc.

· Wipe up spills with a sponge or a dishcloth instead of paper towels

- · Repair items that can be fixed instead of just throwing them out and buying new
- Use a mug, cup or glass instead of disposable cups
- Use cloth diapers as opposed to the disposable kind
- · Use rechargeable batteries. Disposable batteries can leak mercury, lead and nickel into the environment

#### MISCELLANEOUS

- Purchase recycled products to help stimulate the market
- · Stop your junk mail
- · Tell a friend

LFYC TENNIS COURT RULES

The tennis court is intended for the use of all members of LFYC and their accompanied guests. Court use will be governed by the following rules:
