- Tied (not bagged) newspapers

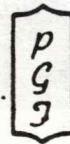

LIFFY ISLAND

Many Lake Forest residents have been watching the recent governmental happenings regarding the Liffy Island this spring and summer. Ownership of the island, a pristine tract directly across from the Clubhouse, is shared by Jefferson Township and developer Paul Trendowicz. Jefferson purchased its chunk of the island a few years ago in order to halt development, Mr. Trendowicz is seeking to build homes on his piece — 39 homes on the mainland portion, and 5 homes on his island acreage. After months of wrangling Trendowicz gained Jeff. Twp. Planning Board approval, but with a provision that he must construct a heavy duty bridge to the island. Township planners hope this provision will prove cost prohibitive and/or that the NJ DEP will not grant the approvals necessary to construct the bridge.

Lake Forest residents have attended Township Planning Board and Council in support of a building prohibition on the island and township purchase of Trendowicz's island property. The Lake Hopatcong Regional Planning Board has pledged its entire annual land acquisition budget to aid in the purchase, and the Delaware River Watershed association has placed acquisition and legal action on the agenda of its August meeting in Trenton.

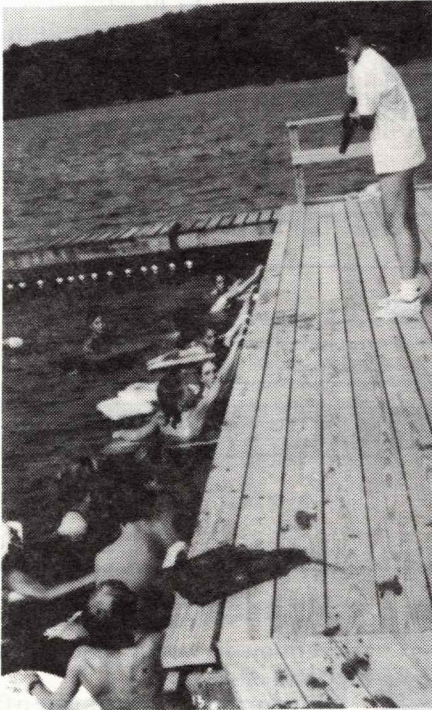

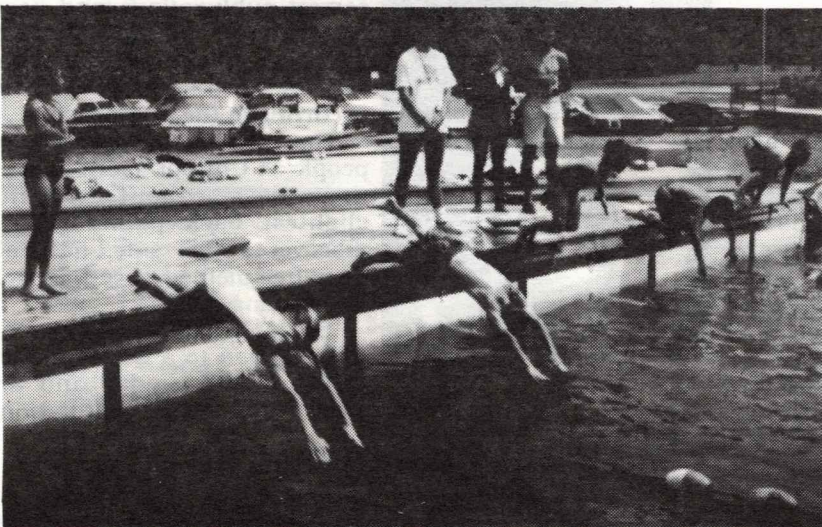
SWIM STROKES LAKE FOREST SWIM TEAM NEWS

LFYC TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

June 11, 1991

(Minutes are synopsisized, For a complete copy, please see Margaret at the LFYC office.)

SWIM TEAM Swim Team requested discussion on use of swim lanes when team is not using them for practice or meets. If lanes are to be open for use by LFYC members during times the team is not holding regularly scheduled practices or meets then insurance must be addressed. After some discussion this was tabled till July meeting. Use of clubhouse for team meetings and fundraisers was also discussed, deciding that since this is a start-up year team could use clubhouse at no cost, but this would be subject to review next year. Team is in process of constructing fence and gate at catwalk side of swim dock to restrict access to catwalk.

HOUSE Discussion on rental fees and deposit now required being too low. Present fees do not cover costs for cleaning, electric, etc. Some damage has occurred to 3 of tables probably from people standing on them. Suggested that someone inspect premises (tables, chairs, properly used/put away) before and after each rental—if need to pay someone this could be covered by increased rental fee; increased deposit would pay for repairs. Discussion tabled. Margaret will order 6 sets of table legs.

MEMBERSHIP Homeowners whose property falls within Lake Forest geographically but whose deeds, by design or neglect, do not show Master Lease was offered for discussion. Discussed how this occurs, how to address these questions: when resident wants to be included or does not want inclusion. Discussion on how pro-rating works for each of the billings LFYC bills new members.

BEACH W.A.T.E.R. Works, Inc. will test beach waters this season and send report to LFYC and Jeff. Twp. Board of Health as required.

GALLEY REM Vending has decided not to service LFYC this year. They offered to sell club a soda machine @ \$700. and candy machine @ \$300. with REM maintaining them. New resident/member had expressed interest in running galley this summer—but recent contact from her is unavailable. Installation of coin phone was discussed.

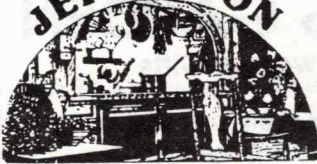
