#### **Trustee Meeting Minutes**

September 11, 2014

Trustees Present: Ray Calogero, Jeff Dowd, Mike Kahwaty, Kim Good, Dan Schultz Greg Struble and Jon Schiedlo Sr.

Beach: The clean up/close down date has been set for October 11th with a rain date of October 12th. Dan is looking into a different design for the outside shower as it is in need of repair. This will be a spring project.

Budget: Budget from this FY was reviewed and discussion ensued with regard to creating next year's budget. Jon will put something together to be voted on at next meeting.

By Laws: Discussion ensued with regards to some proposed by law changes. A suggestion was made to have the by law committee review them and give their thoughts. A motion was made. See Motions.

Docks: Dan would like to raise the Dock Expense Budget for next year. He also wants to put together a member project to do some minor repairs to the catwalk/ docks to save money.

Nominating: Duane Mapes will be the head of this committee. Still in need of one more member. He will be reaching out to the members to get together.

Nursery School: The school has received interest from alumni parents to help with the reorganization of the school. They still want to run the charity event on October 5th.

Office: Rentals were reviewed by the board. August meeting minutes were approved.

Social: Discussion ensued with regard to Closing Day. Greg asked that if any servicing, maintenance, etc. that needs to be done to the kegurators, to call him and he will handle as he signed on to be in charge of the maintenance on them.

Tennis: The contractor is not getting back to Mike with regard to painting the lines on the court for Pickleball. The cracks and repairs caused from the winter were done at no cost to the club. A new roller refill was purchased. A push broom will also be purchased.

Welcome Packet: The packet is done and will be sent to the printer for printing and then it will be distributed to all households.

Old Business: Mike informed the board that he has ordered the new window for the Porthole in the clubhouse. When it arrives he will install it and seal and paint it.

Our landscaper spoke to Mike about the volley ball project. The landscaper can dig 6"

down and throw sand in that area to make the ground softer as a request by some members. He will get a quote to Mike for the job.

The board wants to replace the metal door to the clubhouse with a glass door. Cost to replace will about \$2200. Board wants to move forward with this project.

Mike is working on gathering proposals to repair/replace the parking lot. Greg is working on gathering proposals to do major repairs to A Docks.

New business: Discussion ensued with regard to raising the Master lease fee as it would be 5 years in 2015 since the last increase. Jon will bring to next meeting to discuss and vote.

Motions: Jon made a motion to present all of the proposed amendments to the by laws to the committee for review. Mike seconded it. All in favor.
