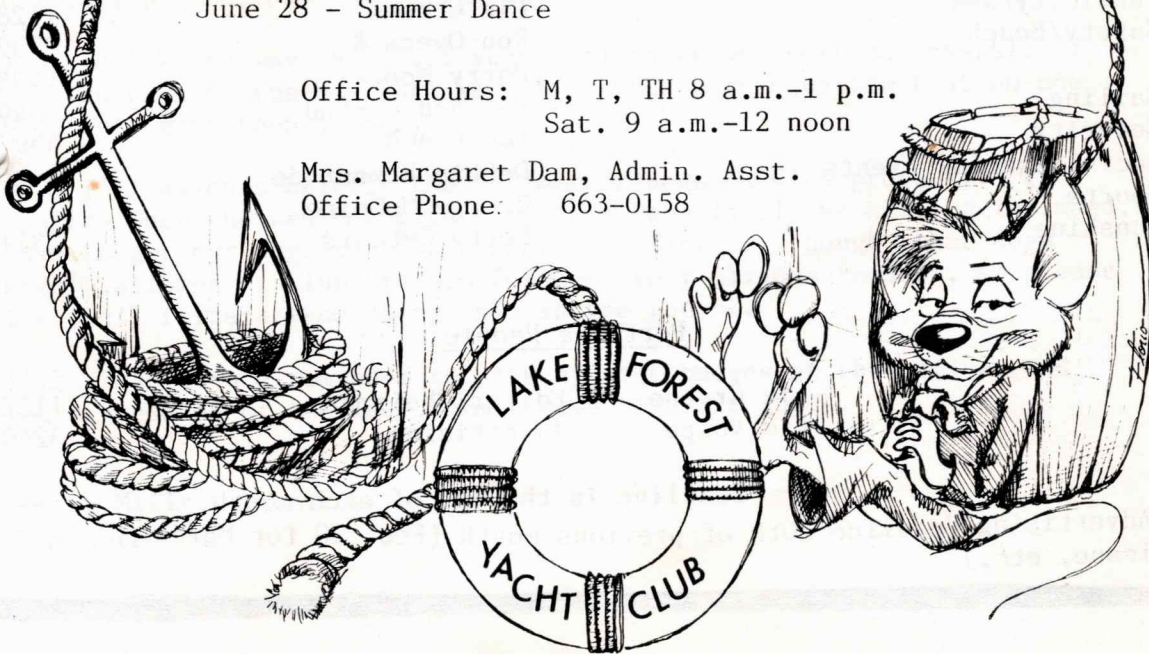

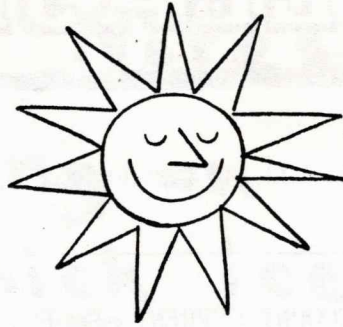
Dumpster is not intended for use by anyone other than the Club. The
