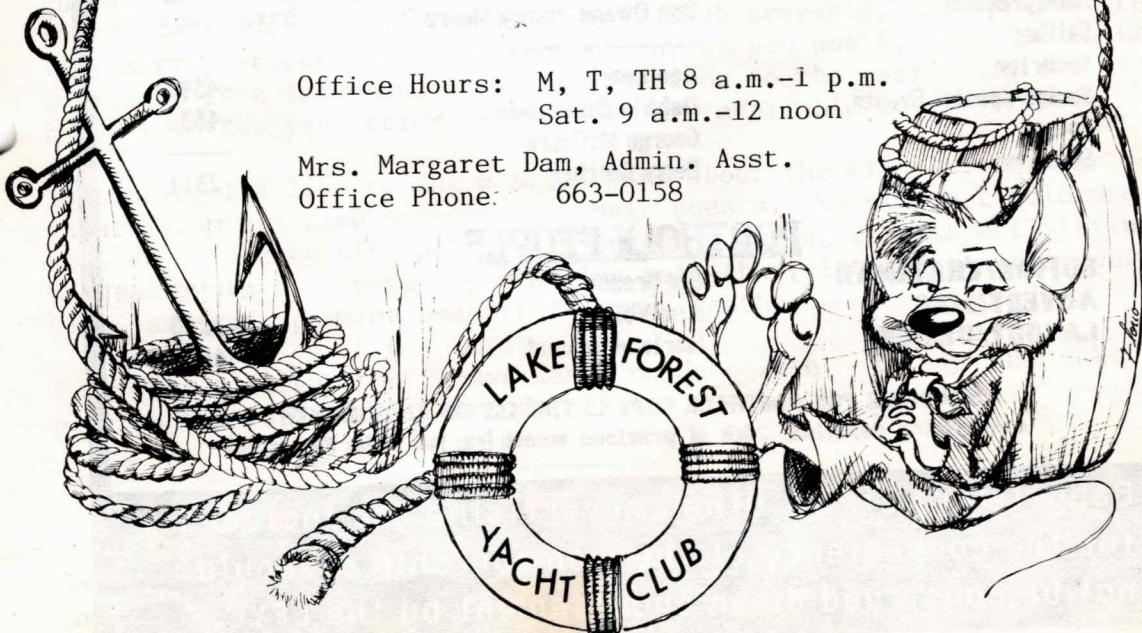

## Commodore's Message

Dear LFYC Members,

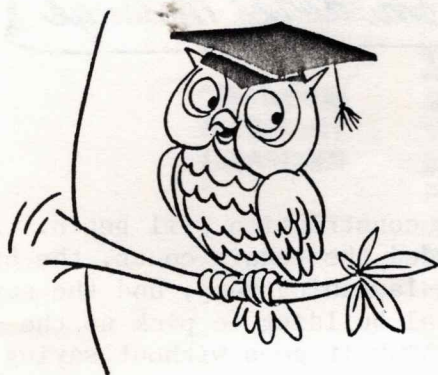
With the beginning of June the Club's new construction will begin. As I write this the contractor that was awarded the tennis court, the hand-ball court, relocation of the road to the launching ramp, and the new dumpster pad is on his way to the municipal building to pick up the necessary permits to begin the work. I think it goes without saying that all of us are extremely happy to see some projects begin, and barring any problems with the town, they should start immediately. The progress at B & C docks and the non-start of the retaining wall for the beach have been a big disappointment to the Trustees, and anyone else who has been associated with Walter at AAA Construction. We have directed that AAA complete the docks immediately and start the retaining wall, or we will be forced to find someone more forthcoming with their labor.

We've developed our yearly compliance problem regarding the wearing of beach badges, and getting everyone to put the new stickers on their vehicles. The new stickers go on the passenger rear window, or as close to that position as you can get them so as to be visible to the guard. We are giving out two new stickers per family. If you have a third vehicle you expect to drive onto Club property, your present rear view mirror sticker will suffice so long as you notify Mrs. Dam in the office so this information can be passed on to the guard. If you haven't gotten your stickers yet they are available in the office.

In closing I'd like to say a brief word about the kind of behavior we expect from all Club members and their guests. We will not tolerate abusive or destructive behavior. Anyone engaging in such activity will be dealt with appropriately. Having said that, let's just enjoy our Club, and the upcoming beautiful summer weather.

P.S. Don't forget the Summer Dance on June 28th. We may just take our play on the road (or be forced to!).

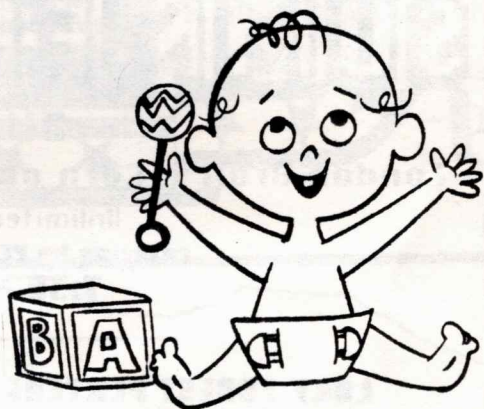

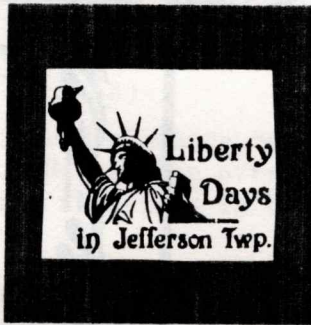

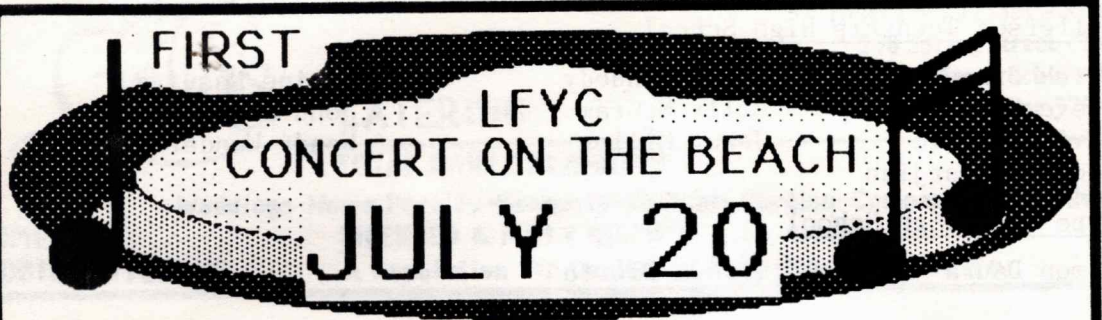

On May 23 LFYC Superior Court Judge Stein denied our motion to recognize a small group of individual LFYC property owners and members as a class representing all property owners and members. He ordered that all reasonably ascertainable property owners be named as defendants. He also ordered that the verification and notification processes be abbreviated somewhat. Therefore, you will soon be seeing notices in the local papers, the PORTHOLE and in direct mailings to all property owners and members apprizing you of the situation and ultimately naming each of us as defendants. If you support the legal efforts of the club to gain "quiet title" then no action is required or necessary on your part. Please watch this space for monthly updates on what will be the final chapters of LFYC's long-standing (approaching 6 years) efforts to clear title and prepare this property for sale.
