
# LK. FOREST'S JEREMY BAILER #1 IN NEW JERSEY

March 9, 1993

SOCIAL Brunch on Feb. 14 was a social success, loss was \$67.65 because couldn't accurately judge supplies needed without advance reservations. Steak-Out, to launch summer season, scheduled for June 26. Annual bus trip to Mets baseball game not scheduled for this year due to poor sales last year, and not many Saturday home games. Cost of Yankee ticket \$4. more than Mets.

**PROPERTY** Twp. has not responded to letter asking about its possible interest in Commodore/Harbor land.

BUDGET Trustees reviewed budget, asking for bids on some contracts.

**SEPTIC SYSTEM** Leaching field for Clubhouse located behind boat ramp. Exact location will be ID'd then fenced so cars/trailers do not park over it.

**DOCKS** Ron & Bernard checking on cost & siting of access gate to dock area from a couple of different companies so it can be installed by start of boating season.

MAINTENANCE Water leak found to be meter therefore Township will pay for repair. Meter will be moved to avoid future breaks. Tilted post will be righted when ground is OK. Trustees began compiling list of items in need of attention for Clean-Up Day, May 8.

**BEACH** New slide & weed control contract discussed. Lk. Hopatcong Reg. Planning Bd. may put together lake-wide contract in which LFYC would participate—as we did last year.

SUNSHINE COMMITTEE Ginny will pursue reactivating committee to send acknowledgements to members in event of death, birth or illness.

SECURITY Trustees addressed questions regarding snowmobile use of ball field.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT Estimates received for replacement furniture, new floor covering in kitchen & lounge, small refrigerator to replace present one in kitchen (which will be moved to galley). Nursery School will donate window treatment to match new furniture. Cost of repairing collapsing floor edges not included—will be estimated for next mtg.
