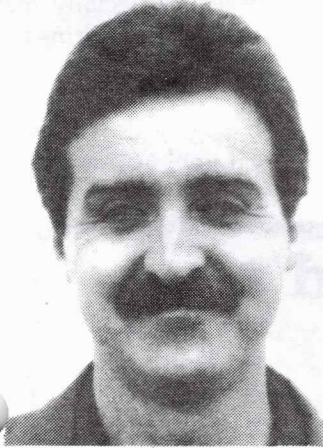
RON MILLER

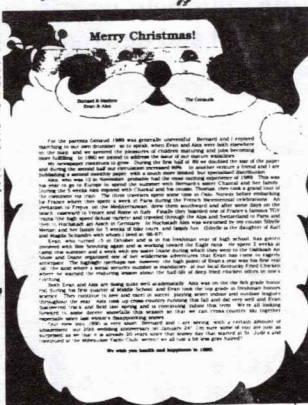

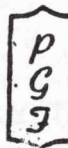

LFYC Dock Lease PROCEDURES & CONDITIONS

- Only LFYC members in good standing will be considered for dock leasing.
- A boat for which dock space is rented must be registered to the name of the member renting the space.
- No boats may be docked until the Lease Agreement has been settled. Boats docked without the Dock Master's approval may be removed at the owner's expense.
- Lessees of dock space may retain their '92 slip in '93 provided that their checks are received before Feb. 15, 1993, with this exception: Size constraints may warrant the change of dock space. (Dock assignments & changes are at the discretion of the Dock Master.) All remaining slips will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Boat must be removed from the dock space by Nov. 15, 1993 or the Club will remove it at the owner's expense. No winter storage is available.
- No boats are to be parked or stored on Club property at any time.
- Any bumper material installed by boat owners must be approved by the Dock Master. Boat owner installed bumper material must be removed by the leasee by Nov. 15, 1993.



LFYC TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

Oct. 13, 1992

NOMINATING Committee has presented the following candidates for 1993-94 Trustees: Bernard Genaud, Cheryl Lusardi, Ronald Miller, Paul Murray.

ANNUAL MEETING LFYC Annual Membership meeting is scheduled for Dec. 4, 1992. Ballots/announcements will be printed and mailed within 30 days of meeting.

REGATTA Trustee Garland reports that committee is still active & may have some sponsor money for July '93 Regatta.

DOCKS Fees will remain same for '93 season. Application will be printed in Nov., Dec., & Jan. Portholes. Deadline date for renewal will again be Feb. 15 (1993). Trustee Garland asked that Board consider new fee of \$25. for members who want to launch boats from ramp but do not rent dock space. Board agreed to wait until Nov. meeting to gauge member response.



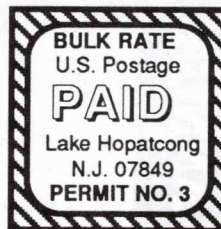
