Miscellaneous Holding CPR course was suggested.


### LFYC SPECIAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES

He then outlined background information: after an original price of \$50,000. owner Griswold agreed to a Trustee offer of \$5,000. and waiving of outstanding master lease. Club atty. drew

up contract which was signed by Griswolds and Trustees subject to membership approval.

Mr. & Mrs. Johanson, owners of the property on the other side of the Griswold lot approached the Trustees about buying the property from the Club. The Johansons were interested in having the Club assign the contract to them under the following terms: price of \$15,000. plus master lease of \$2,211.56, subject to membership approval.

The Trustees presented following 3 options for discussion: 1) purchase property for Club, 2) do not purchase property, 3) purchase property and assign to Johansons. Option 3 was

recommended to membership. Meeting was opened for discussion.

Some of the following comments were expressed by members: concern that the Club was making a profit from a Club member, concern that the tax exempt status of the Club would be adversely effected, questions about how the purchaser planned to use the lot.

Mr. Johanson requested time to address the membership, stating: he planned to use the lot only as a visual and noise buffer between his property and the Club, that he did not feel the Club was taking advantage of him regarding the price — that \$15,000 was what he thought was the fair market value of the property and that "it is only good business to get the best price you can for whatever you have to sell and being in business (he) understood that the Trustees were only doing the best they could for the Club".

Amotion was made and seconded to authorize the LFYC Board of Trustees to take steps necessary to purchase lots 31 and 31A, Block 121 on the tax map of the Township of Jefferson and assign a contract of sale on property to a third party under the following terms: 1) Purchase Contract \$5,000 net of all past due master lease payments plus the sellers reasonable attorneys fees. 2) Assignment agreement \$15,000 plus all past due master lease



### LFYC TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

August 13, 1991

(Minutes are synopsized, For a complete copy, please see Margaret at the LFYC office.)

House Grace Bacorn, house chairperson, met with Trustees to review end of season record. She reported that Clubhouse rentals increased this year. A question was raised about whether current rental price of \$100. with deposit of \$50 was sufficient — tables were broken, after repairing ten of them six additional sets of legs were needed; plus propane and electric bills are high especially during summer rentals. It was proposed that a higher fee could cover cost of hiring person to inspect Clubhouse and equipment after each rental, however Grace said she was concerned that people wouldn't rent Clubhouse if fee was raised and she enjoys being House Chairperson and doesn't see need for paid personnel. House rules will be prominently displayed emphasizing tables & chairs put in proper storage spots, double locking back door, and placing of garbage inside dumpster. Grace also reported that Swim Team sometimes did not clean up well after their use: left supplies and items in refrigerator, sandy floors in main room and bathroom; but after they were contacted there was improvement. Communication will be key in '92.

Taxes Professional appraisals have been received and Club Atty Ann Huber has sent notification to Morris Cty that we will be seeking to have the appraisals changed. Nominating Committee Trustee Paul Murray will contact 3 members of LFYC to serve, in addition to those elected by membership: Jim Bashant, Robbie Levinson, Harry Moore. Slate must be complete by Oct. 31 to meet legal requirements for Dec. 6 meeting.

### LFYC Trustees Meeting Minutes

September 10, 1991

(Minutes are synopsized, For a complete copy, please see Margaret at the LFYC office.) Insurance Multi-peril policy has been received including auto liability & fire coverage for all buildings and docks.

Land Sales Purchase of Griswold property is proceeding.

Swim Team Jim Bashant, head of LFST board, attended meeting to discuss protecting new swim dock from ice damage, fire insurance for swim dock, septic pump-out schedule and requesting the use of galley space for storage/running food concession for the Club. Storage of signs, kickboards, leg floats as well as winter storage of lane lines, flags, etc. could be consolidated in galley. During season team proposed having 3-4 LFYC member/swimmers sell cold snacks for Club approx. 11:30am to 2pm, 7 days/week; team parents would run it for home meets with hot & cold snacks.

Docks Dock renters on A dock need to get their boats out of their slips to prevent damage to their boats. Water level of lake is extremely low and dropping affecting A dock the most. Budget Unknown amount of property tax bill prompted discussion on need to raise dues or other means of raising funds.


