Trustee Meeting Minutes June 10, 2015

Trustees Present: Ray Calogero, Dan Schultz, Greg Struble, Jon Schiedlo Sr., Keith Moran, Anna Carrion & Mike Kahwaty

Beach/Galley: Dan let the board know that at the moment we don't have a working AED. It needs a battery. Mike offered to take it to have it tested and if it passes, the board has decided to purchase a new battery and use this one. Keith would like to purchase a spare tire for the wheelbarrow so that if it is needed there is no urgency to run out to get one. Discussion ensued with regard to the beach procedures.

Budget: Jon began looking at the financials but needs to take a closer look to determine if and what the board can spend on the facilities for the remainder of the year. Possibly security cameras, siding of clubhouse, electric near GAGA pit and horseshoe pit, etc.

Clubhouse: Mike advised that there is an issue with regard to how the renters are putting back the tables and chairs in the big closet. Suggestion was made to make a rules poster with photos to show how it gets put back.

Docks/Grounds: The contractor will be starting on June 11th. Ray spoke with the electrician who will fix all of the outlets/plugs and add more outlets. He will be adding 3 lights on each dock for additional ground lighting. They fixed the guide wire that fell down over by the basketball court.

Grounds: Discussion ensued with regard to purchasing additional picnic tables. Decision was made to purchase 4 new tables. Landscaper will level out the area between the beach and the parking lot. Discussion ensued about what to put down on the ground. Most likely it will be sand.

LFST: The contract has been signed and filed in the office.

Maintenance: Discussion ensued with regard to renewing the Blue Diamond Contract. Decision was made to renew with them for 3 years.

Office: Meeting Minutes for May meeting were reviewed. Rentals were reviewed.

Security: Mike advised the board that we will have a new guard named Michelle who will be our Security guard on a regular basis.

Social: The board reviewed the events. Duane will run 2 events per month on the beach. Question was asked, will there be a camp out on the beach this year. Decision was made to have event.
