

#### **Trustee Meeting Minutes**

March 13, 2014

Trustees Present: Ray Calogero, Jeff Dowd, Mike Kahwaty, Kim Good, Dan Schultz and Greg Struble

Grant: As of March 1st applicants may complete and file for the scholarship. Discussion ensued with regard to deciding on a time limit when to turn in the transcript in order to receive the scholarship check if an situation arises when the student cannot provide this information after the first semester (illness, injury, etc. preventing them to complete the semester).

**Audit:** Still waiting for the auditor to give us her results. Accountant has reached out to her to follow up.

Presentation by the Lake Hopatcong Foundation: The board discussed this and advised that they can present at the start of the meeting which would be 8:15 and they will ask if they can limit their time to 20 mins.

**Boat Races:** Ray reported that Jay Mueller met with Mayor Felter to go over the details of this event. He has gotten the okay from the State Marine Police to hold the event on the weekend of May 2 – 4, 2014. The marine police will be cordoning off the area for 2 days (Saturday and Sunday) of that weekend. Ray would like to meet with Jay to go over what we need from him and would like to do it next week sometime.

Beach/Galley: . Dan informed the board that we have issued the first payment of \$400 with the signed proposal for this season. Dan asked if we could post something in the porthole about offering this service to all Lake Forest residents along the water. Dan informed the board that we are receiving applications from some of the returning guards as well as new guards. He will be reviewing them shortly as well as reaching out to others to see if they will be returning.

Concession Stand: Rebecca D'Alauro has offered to help run the stand this year. A request was made to post something in the Porthole about it and ask if anyone would be interested in helping her. A member has expressed interested in possibly helping.

**Office:** Meeting minutes and rentals were reviewed and approved.

**Social:** Discussion ensued with regard to who the current members of the committee are and reaching out to past members to see who will make up the committee. A request was made to put something in the Porthole to get the word out there about putting in requests to use the club for an event that an organization a member is involved with (charities, etc.) to be held in the fall.

**Swim Team:** Contract has been reviewed by both parties, signed and filed with the office.

**LFNS:** The school is still moving forward with registration. They are waiting to make a decision whether or not to keep the school open until they see how many registrations they can get. They have 5 registrations so far and a possible 10 in the waiting.

**Tennis:** Mike advised that shortly he will look to flip the wind fence over and tack it down so it stops lifting up with the wind.

Parking Lot: Mike informed the board that he is working with Fitzpatrick and Sons to get a bid for this project but he needs to wait for the snow to melt so he can see what the job will entail in order to bid it properly

**Expansion Committee:** Jeff advised that he will be getting the expansion committee together to put together a presentation for the Semi-Annual meeting including drawings, etc. He will speak to Jon about setting a budget for this project.

**Welcoming/Membership:** Packets will be printed soon. Working on the sponsorships for the packet.

**Legal & Insurance:** Discussion ensued with regard to replacing the Excess Liability insurance for the next renewal in February 2015. Contacts were made to several agencies to provide us with quotes.

Waiting for this information so the board can make a decision and budget for this extra expense.

Maintenance/Grounds: Discussion ensued with regard to the floors in the clubhouse. Greg advised that he had a contractor take a look at it. There are loose tiles in front of the doors. Sills need to be repaired/replaced as moisture has gotten in them. Discussion ensued about the possibility of installing a glass door in front where the entrance is located. They also talked about installing a card reader to enter into the club.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

**Senior Memberships:** Discussion ensued with regard to what age the senior membership would begin. This will be discussed at the semi-annual meeting to get members opinions regarding this change.

Rental of Facilities for a National Kayak polo Tournament: Member is Kathleen Lynch. — Discussion ensued and they would like to meet with Kathy to discuss further. Office Manager will respond to the email and ask if she can attend the next Workshop meeting on March 27th at 7pm.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

As we are grateful to all organizations we also must balance the needs of the members usage of the club.
