

As promised in last month's PORTHOLE enclosed are three (3) letters randomly addressed to three (3) different Morris Corty Freeholders objecting to the siting of an incinerator in Jerrerson Township. If you are opposed to having an incinerator in Jefferson please sign each copy and mail them as soon as possible. The number of people who register their opposition is of greater importance than the economic or ecological facts.

Last month's PORTHOLE reported that the NJDEP (Dept. of Environmental Protection) recommended a previously rejected Rockaway Township site for the new Morris County landfill. After 2,000 Rockaway Twp. residents met to protest the recommendation the state quickly dropped that recommendation and urged the county to look at the previously rejected #2 site in Mt. Olive. (The previously rejected #3 site is in Roxbury at the sw foot of Lake Hopatcong.)

a non-partisan committee of concerned residents and officials has been formed and funded by the Jefferson Twp. Council and Mayor. The committee meets weekly with the twp. atty and consultants to work out a plan of action should the Bechtel report recommend a Jeff Twp. site for the county's incinerator. The Bechtel report is scheduled for late November completion.
