Can you attend a monthly meeting? "Are you able to handle any responsibilities during the day? ""Are you available on the weekends? " Does your schedule allow you to oversee the various subcommittees that may be assigned to you?

4. Special Skills:

What is your occupation? "Do you have any special hobbies or interests that would benefit the club? "What is your personality like? "Can you motivate people?

5. Goals for the club:

What is your vision for future of the club? "Why are you running for trustee?

Please plan to attend the Lake Forest Yacht Club Annual Meeting, at which the election will be held. The meeting is December 7, 2012, at 8:00pm. A guorum must be reached by 8:15pm. As per the By-Laws, all members must be "in good standing" to vote --meaning the property's Master Lease and the 1st half of Membership Dues billed 10/1/12 must be paid. "Absentee ballots must be received at the LFYC Office by Thursday, December 6, 2012. Please stop in at the LFYC Office prior to deadline. "There will be no allowances for reception of absentee ballots after this time.
