

LFYC TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

Dec. 8, 1992

(Minutes are synopsized, For a complete copy, please see Margaret at the LFYC office.)

MISC. QUESTIONS FOR THE TWP. – Leak from Water Main/Meter Twp. Admin. Robt. Cutter attended meeting to discuss resolution of chronic problems with water leak from underground meter in parking lot. Twp. Water Utility would like to see installation of meters in Clubhouse and Galley to eliminate problem. Question regarding whether Club or Twp. has paid for digging and plumber in past will be researched by Mrs. Dam. Additional discussion needed on need for 1 or 2 meters and how to bill for seasonal use of Galley. Harbor/Commodore Land Per members input at '92 Annual Meeting Mr. Cutter was asked whether twp. would be interested in land for well siting. He doubted if construction of well is possible because it is a wetland. He suggested that Trustees write to Council and Mayor requesting Twp. acceptance of land.

FINANCIAL - Trustees reviewed performance of '92 Accountant McGough.

DOCK LEASE – Question raised at Annual Meeting regarding dock lease has been checked independently by 2 Trustees, who reported that it is standard and will hold-up.

CATWALKS – Steve Uranyi submitted estimate for repair to some of boards on B & C docks, but reported that barge w/pile driver will be needed for other repairs. Estimates were received from Prospect Point Boatyard for doing work on 15 ft. catwalk w/new float. Trustees voted to go ahead w/Uranyi and Prospect Pt repair jobs.

LFYC Dock Lease **PROCEDURES & CONDITIONS**

Only LFYC members in good standing will be considered for dock leasing.

 A boat for which dock space is rented must be registered to the name of the member renting the space.

 No boats may be docked until the Lease Agreement has been settled. Boats docked without the Dock Master's approval may be removed at the owner's expense.

 Leasees of dock space may retain their '92 slip in '93 provided that their checks are received before Feb. 15, 1993, with this exception: Size constraints may warrant the change of dock space. (Dock assignments & changes are at the discretion of the Dock Master.) All remaining slips will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

• Boat must be removed from the dock space by Nov. 15, 1993 or the Club will remove it

at the owner's expense. No winter storage is available.

No boats are to be parked or stored on Club property at any time.

• Any bumper material installed by boat owners must be approved by the Dock Master. Boat owner installed bumper material must be removed by the lease by Nov. 15, 1993.


