Lake Forest Facilities Update

Now that we are starting the winter months at the club, our projects will consist mostly of indoor projects. Here is an update on our club facility and activities:

Walkway Renovation Project:

The new paver walkway was installed in November and it has made a dramatic difference. The overgrown shrubs

are gone and we have a nice wide walk area. We also installed new drainage which has eliminated the puddling problem we had near the club entrance. This area will receive additional attention in the Spring as we repaint the clubhouse exterior, adjoining wall and playground wall. We also plan on placing large potted plants and a bench in the area this Spring.

Proposed New Paver Patio:

At the December 1st annual meeting, membership will see plans for a new paver patio on the lakeside grassy area of the clubhouse. The plan is to remove the grassy area between the clubhouse and the retaining wall leading to the beach area. We would use the same style pavers we used on the walkway which would improve our

club's appearance. We also plan on several commercial grade picnic tables with umbrellas on the patio for members use. Not only would this help improve the club appearance in that area, it will make that patio area more functional for club activities and member rentals.

we're planning on having repaired by the end of the month. Those projects include replacing the defective fan in the ladies room, installing a vent fan in the kitchen area, minor floor repair in the kitchen and sealing the wall opening where our new HVAC lines are coming in. All these repairs will be in advance of our proposed clubhouse renovation project being presented to membership at the Annual Meeting.

The two old clubhouse kegeaters have been sold and the funds have been deposited into the Social Committee budget for the 2007 Social activities.

Docks and Canoe Rack

All boats and canoes have been removed from the dock slips and canoe rack and they both are now closed for the year. The docks and canoe rack will reopen for member boats on April 1st. Member dock renewal invoices will be going out in January and renewals must be paid by March 15th, 2007 to retain your slip. New member rentals will be assigned after the rental renewal period ends on March 15th. The canoe rack access is free of charge on a first come first serve basis.
