LFYC UPDATES

Members/prospective members find some LFYC terminology confusing or downright incompreensible. Here's a short reference on the most frequently mentioned bugaboos:

Member in Good Standing In order to vote at the annual and semi annual meetings members must be in "good standing". For the Dec. Annual Meeting this means that by the close of business prior to the meeting a member has paid at least half of the special assessment and is current with Master Lease (paid thru 3rd quarter-Sept. 30). For the May Semi-Annual Meeting this means that by the close of business prior to the meeting a member has paid in full both the special assessment and dues and is current with Master Lease (paid thru quarter ending before the meeting date).

Badges In order to be issued badges a member must have all obligations paid in full: dues, special assessment, guest badge fees (if ordered); also bond account and Master Lease must be current.

Dock Space Dock applications will be accepted from members who have paid half of their dues, all of the special assessment, are current with Master Lease (paid thru quarter ending Dec. 30), have paid the full dock fee, and have submitted a properly completed application. Bond Refund In order to receive a bond refund the following conditions must be met: a letter of resignation must submitted to the Board of Trustees, the bond must be presented, all obli-gations to the Club must be current. (Obliga-tions not current will be paid by reducing the bond value by the amount due. When the obligations exceed the value of the bond, the dues and special assessment-club obligations-will take precedence over all other debt.)

Members in good standing (note bugaboos above), and non-profit groups upon approval of Board of Trustees.

What?

The Clubhouse, outdoor facilities are not included in rental. Renters are responsible for cleaning facility after renting.

- \$100 fee/\$50 deposit Standard Rental

LFNS children had a very special guest at their Valentine's Party-a purple dinosaur who sang their favorite songs with them







Feb. 9, 1993

GENERAL LFYC annual contribution to Jefferson Fire Co. is use of property for drills & Christmas party. Jefferson Twp Creative Playground Committee Apr. use for fundraiser OK'd if meet insuran

requirements, provide info on % of profit.

PROPERTY Bob wrote Twp. about intent to sell Commodore property & asking if twp. has interest in purchase. Bob & Ron also contacting adjacent property owners about purchasing this property. NURSERY SCHOOL LFNS wants to donate window treatment for new windows in Commodore's Room & requested Trustee input. Board noted that \$2000 has been set aside for upgrading for this area, so coordinating efforts is important. Ginny will check on this.

GALLEY Bernard found price of approx. \$1000. to install new grease trap. Motion passed to repair sink, install new grease trap & connect lines to dry well not to exceed \$1000.

PROPERTY LEIN Ron is pursuing filing liens for non-payment of Master Lease.

BUDGET Peter reported change in 911 return means \$1000 IRS refund. Accountant believes profit from property sale may be used to make improvements. With revenues from membership & docks down, limited membership to outsiders was discussed. Cheryl will checkt on non-profit status...
