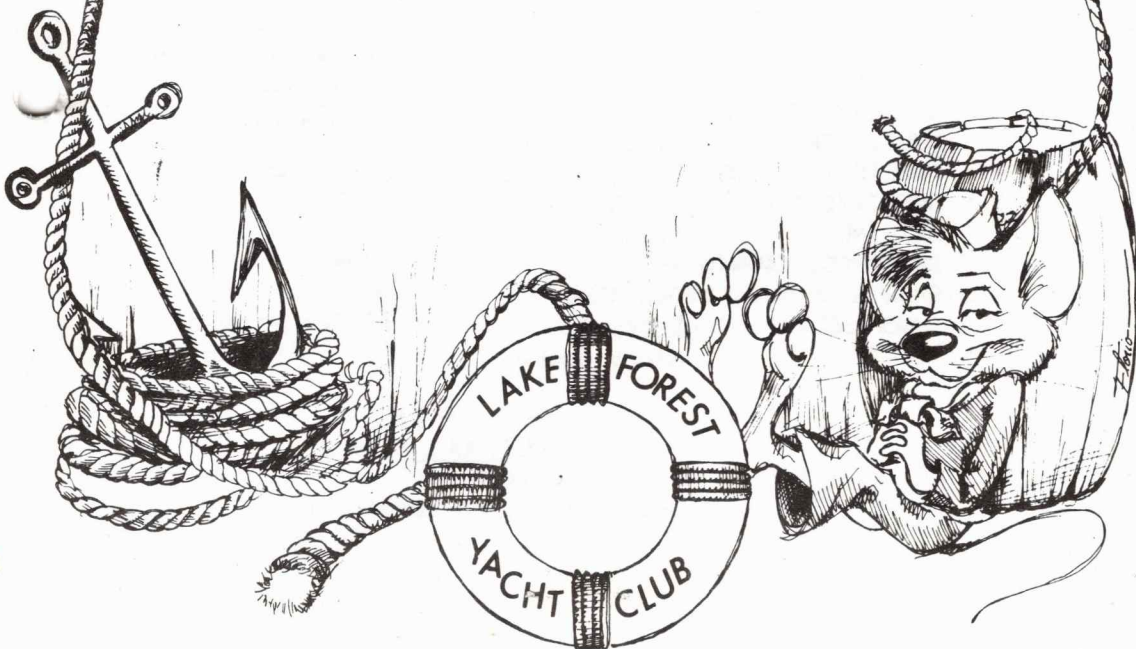

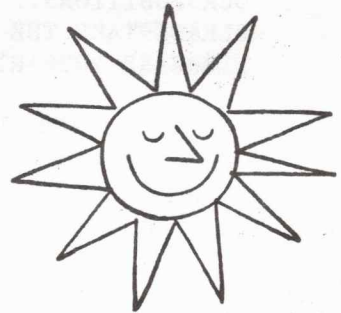



SYNOPSIS OCT TRUSTEE MEETING

MULTI-YEAR COMMITTEE

Specific problems as to the wall were discussed. It was decided that a settlement price as well as specific items to be corrected will be offered to Walter.

Mickey Yorkston will not be in charge of the Multi-Year Committee when he retires as a trustee in Dec.

At this point prices for the roof have not been received. Several members have been in contact with contractors and are still waiting for firm prices.

BY-LAWS

The board felt that a committee should be formed to research some changes that may be necessary in our By-Laws. Several names were suggested and they will be contacted.

BUDGET

The Trustees voted to increase the dues by 10%, effective 10/1/87. This was done as provided in the By-Laws.

A discussion was held noting that 10% was not enough to make up for the shortfall. Mickey & Pete will work on the budget for 87/88 and the Trustees will review it and decide how much more of an increase will be needed to make up the shortfall. It may be necessary to go to the membership in Dec. for another increase.

RECREATION

The fun-run was rained out & will be rescheduled on 10/25. Rich Giessuebel will give a slide show on fishing on 10/16/87. Flyers will be sent out. The picnic tables will be put away for the winter.

SECURITY

Security will be reduced to weekends after 10/31. Winter security will be Fri., Sat., & Sun.

GROUNDS

Wayne Cornelius will remove the garbage and rocks and clean up the beach area near the point since the lake is down. New sand will be dumped in this area thus hoping to pick up more beach area which is presently unuseable due to the rocks.

Phil reported that Diane Faruolo requested to address the board about forming a Lake Forest swimteam. She was unable to attend tonight's meeting. When Diane is ready there may be a special Trustee meeting to address the issue.
