
















Lake Loop 2014

We are glad to announce a 3 mile walk added NEW this year! It will be a great day that includes an organized ride or walk, live music by Byrdgrass, delicious food and lots of FUN!

Getting Started: Register at "lakehopatcongfoundation.org". Registration is FREE but we ask that participants raise \$100 for the lake. Crowdrise will help you create a fundraising page to reach out to friends, family and co-workers to reach fundraising goals that will earn you exciting rewards! Kids 5-12 are a flat fee of \$5 and can also create a fundraising page to earn prizes!

Lake Loop Options: NEW! 3-Mile Walk - The 3-mile walk trails down through King's Cove and around Bertrand's Island before heading back to the finish line at Nixon School. 20- or 40-Mile Bike Routes - The cycling course goes clockwise around the lake and consists of roughly 20 miles of rolling terrain. The course is not flat but there are no significant hills that might deter those looking for an enjoyable ride. The 40-mile course includes a challenging hilly 20 mile extension added to the middle of the 20-mile course.



August 14, 2014

Trustees Present: Ray Calogero, Jeff Dowd, Mike Kahwaty, Kim Good, Dan Schultz and Greg Struble

Beach/Galley: There have been some issues with the outdoor shower and Dan will be working on correcting it. Dan is working on fixing the American Flag on the dive tower pole. Greg will replace a couple of the ladder steps that are broken.

By-Laws: Jeff provided a PowerPoint presentation of suggested changes to the By laws. Discussion ensued. There will be a meeting that any member is welcome to attend for further discussion. Ray suggested that the board members bring their ideas/concerns to the workshop meeting coming up. Further discussion will take place.

Clubhouse: There are several projects that the board is contemplating and will work on putting together. One of them is replacing the front entrance to the clubhouse. Discussion ensued about replacing the porthole window as well. Greg is looking into getting pricing to scrape and paint clubhouse. Mike offered to help with it.

Docks: Dock repairs are being planned for when the boats are out of the water. Some work has been done already this season and there may be additional work before the

season is over. If that is the case, we will notify the boat renters accordingly. Suggestion was made to add jet ski slips at the end of A Dock by the point. Looking for volunteers to help with dock work. Please contact Dan Schultz.

Financials: Financials were reviewed. Jon asked the board to come to the workshop meeting with ideas on the dock work so he can work on the budget.

Office: Rentals were reviewed. July Meeting Minutes were approved.

Nominating: Need 3 more people to form the committee from any area. Kim is sending out an email on it.

Nursery School: The school board has informed Mike that they are going to take the year off to re-structure/re-organize the school. They are looking to start up in September 2015. They will contact the LFYC Board in January with a proposal for some changes. They will keep the board informed as the restructuring takes place. They will take a day to go through their items stored in the closet. They will run the fundraiser in October.

Security: Background checks will be required for all employees over 18, volunteers, etc. every 2 years. Additional research is being done with regard to this matter. Recommendation of the security company.

Social: Texas Hold Em will be back on October 11th. See details in this issue. A request came from a member to add sand to the volleyball area. Board is in favor. Looking into having it excavated and sand placed there by our landscaper. Will get a price quote. The Sunday Fellowship Service, for members only, will begin on Sept. 7th and held outside weather permitting. As long as there are no rentals we can utilize the clubhouse. Jon will have 2 volunteers to help run this event. Further discussion on this topic will be done at the Annual Meeting.
