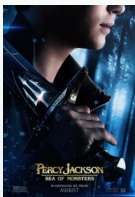

Join our seniors group at the Clubhouse for a little Tai Chi. Although Tai Chi was originally a martial art it is mainly practiced today as an excellent form of exercise with many health benefits.

An exercise that utilizes breathing, visualizations and movements to work the entire body all at once. As The Tai Chi Classics say "If one part of the body moves, the entire body moves". Tai Chi Chuan was created by applying the concept of Tai Chi to very natural movements using relaxation and breathing to generate health, longevity and internal strength and power. The philosophy of Tai Chi is

simple yet profound, in short, the idea that everything consists of two opposing forces that harmonize with each other to create a whole.

Examples : every left has a right, every up has a down, etc..One of the easiest ways to see and understand is with a Taiji diagram

Yang - Yin, White - Black, Exhale - Inhale, Release - Store, Expand - Contract, Give - Receive,
Offense - Defense



Trustee Meeting Minutes

June 12, 2014

Trustees Present: Ray Calogero, Jeff Dowd, Mike Kahwaty, Kim Good, Dan Schultz and Greg Struble

Beach/Galley: There was some confusion with regard to relatives of members taking swim lessons. The decision made by the board was if a member takes care of/babysits a relative (grandchild, niece, etc.) or that person is residing with the member, they may take swim lessons at our beach.

Clubhouse: Sharon Campbell let the board know that she is raising her rate from \$85 per cleaning to \$100. This difference will be added to the rental fee next year.

Clubhouse Expansion Project: We are looking for members to get involved with this committee. There is a meeting planned for Sunday July 13th and an email blast will go out about it. If you are interested please contact Jeff Dowd or the office.

Docks: Discussion ensued with regard to future repairs to A Dock and improving this area.

GAGA Pit: Jon will order the material shortly and his goal is to have it built by end of July.

Office: rentals were reviewed. It has been decided that the Liquor Factory and True Value accounts will be closed in order to keep

things simpler. Purchases will either be made using the corporate debit card, a board member may use their personal credit card and be reimbursed and orders can be made in advance using the corporate debit card.

Nursery School: Next year's contract has been sent to the school for review and signatures. The school may request some changes and the board is awaiting their response.

Patio Rental Requests: If a member wishes to rent the patio for a fee of \$50, they may only do so between Monday - Friday and may use it up to 5:00pm. Use of the clubhouse will not be permitted and the member is responsible for clean up of patio area that they occupy. Any other time (weekends) a member may use it as long as it does not conflict with any club rental on that day.

Projects: Going forward the board will be focusing on the parking lot, the A Dock Project and the MRR or Member Rec Room. These will be discussed at the Improvement meeting on July 13th. Please contact us if you are interested in helping out.

Security: Discussion ensued about having a member on the books to be a security guard to assist with Al Rossey's guard. Discussion ensued about mandatory photos on next years

badge.

Social: The committee is working on Closing Day. A meeting is scheduled for the end of July. A member has expressed that they may be interested in becoming the social chair. Jim Gilligan will be heading the Dart League. The board agreed to spend \$100 to purchase a second board.

Sunday Fellowship Service: A proposal was presented with regard to this event. Discussion ensued. A Motion was made to hold a special meeting with the members about it.

Tennis: A member has requested a new Dry-Roller or a large push broom. Mike said that he will purchase a broom for the court.
