

Trustee Meeting Minutes July 9, 2015

Trustees Present: Ray Calogero, Dan Schultz, Greg Struble, Jon Schiedlo Sr., Keith Moran, Anna Carrion & Mike Kahwaty

Beach: The board will repair the ice maker rather than buy a new one. Discussed choosing a date for Beach close down/clean up. They are thinking of end of September.

Clubhouse: Mike Received a quote to have interior of clubhouse painted. Closet in the kitchen is now unlocked as per fire code. The board will re-arrange what gets stored in it and make it more usable. Signs will be posted in bathrooms regarding what is acceptable to dispense in the toilet. Small trash cans will be purchased and placed in the ladies room stalls.

Docks: Discussion ensued about completing the area near the new boardwalk with regard to the new step up to it. Board agreed to put stone and dirt & grass. Discussion ensued with regard to weed maintenance, particularly over by A dock.

LFST: Team will hire the security guard to work on Saturday mornings to assist when there are home meets. They can assist with parking. Team will rope off the swim area during home meets.

Maintenance/Grounds: Discussed checking the club after cleanings and rentals. Maintenance of the grounds and grills will be done on a more scheduled basis. We will hire the maintenance crew and have them work every Monday and Tuesday to organize the club closet as well as work on other maintenance tasks. 2 new grills have been purchased for the grounds.

Security: We have been assigned a consistent guard to watch the premises every night. She has been given instructions and rules to enforce. With regard to animals on the grounds, discussion ensued and the only area animals are allowed on the grounds is on the parking lot. Tying or securing animals on a leash is not permitted.

Social: A new ping-pong table has been ordered for the beach. Looking into options for closing day and caterers.
