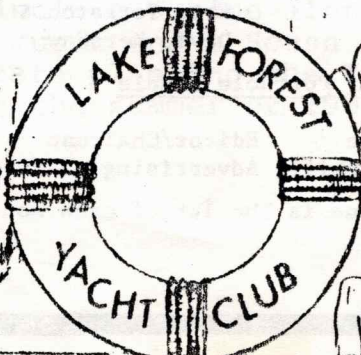

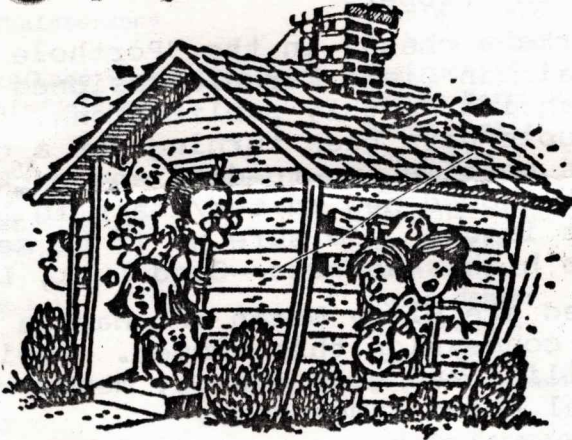

NEWS WATCH

Control of the existing operations and concern about a request for expansion of the Tri-County Asphalt quarrying operation at the north end of Lake Hopafcong was the subject of a meeting in Hopatcong Boro which many concerned LFYC residents attended. (While the operation is in plain view only to Jefferson and particularly Lake Forest residents the Tri-County quarry lies within the border of Sussex County's Hopatcong Boro.) A large crowd of residents complained of night-time blasting and hammering, truck traffic and air and lake pollution and urged Hopatcong to restrict Tri-County's hours of operation, to enforce a stricter noise ordinance and to erect noise barriers between our twp residents and the quarry. Hopatcong's Mayor Hodson plans to request state and company officials for data before initiating any action.

Jefferson Twp Administrator Robert Bowden has resigned effective Sept. 1 to accept a position in Monmouth County. A replacement has not yet been recommended by the Mayor. Mr. Bowden's resignation makes the third twp. position vacated in the past months. Besides the Administrator's position the Director of the Water Utility and Building Dept's Construction Official were recently vacated.

Another suggestion which the Trustees acted upon was to protect boats in our docks. While signs will be posted for the 1986 summer season, effective immediately is a restriction on all fishing from LFYC dock boat slip areas. Past damage was to boat covers, primarily on A dock, from mis-cast hooks, bait cans and lounging fishermen. Please be certain that your children understand this new rule-- it is effective immediately.

Watch for indications of the hard-working renovation committees in the next weeks: Volunteers are needed to canvass members for pledges to purchase LFYC renovation bonds (debentures). Call the office for more info. The co-ordinating committee commissioned an initial drawing of the Clubhouse roof and wall renovations which is on permanent view in the office window facing Yacht Club Dr. Other drawings and a fund-raising gauge will be on view as they are completed.

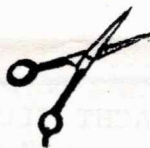

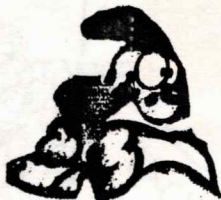
