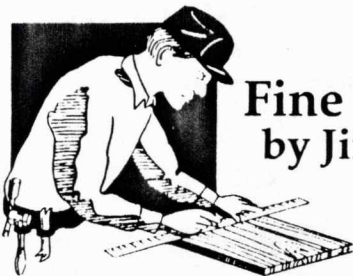

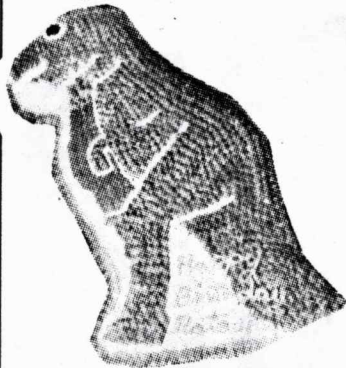

CLUBHOUSE New floor, kitchen cabinets & appliances, furniture installed. Planing of doors, refinishing them & new windows, new stalls in restrms & stove to be completed soon. Payments approved.

OFFICE Copier & fax machine purchase discussed & tabled. Upgrading computer equipment considered.
