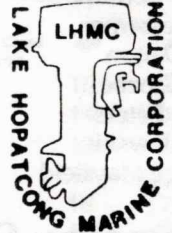

LFYC TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES

August 10, 1993

(The following minutes are synopsized. See Margaret at the LFYC office for a complete set.)

SWIM TEAM LFST President Jim Bashant attended meeting to discuss 1994 League Trials/Finals at Lake Forest. Each of league's 10 teams hosts once/10 yrs. Trials/Finals are potential good money-makers for team and LFYC. Trials are all day event on 1st Thurs. in Aug. Finals are like normal Saturday swim meet—completed by noon Saturday. Swim Team can buy additional insurance for these 2 days. If lake is too low can be hosted at another facility. Trustees tentatively approved.

BUDGET Pete Garland presented 1993-94 budget for discussion. Approved unanimously.

FACILITY Discussion on establishing fund for future replcmtn/repair of docks—tabled. Club will contract to cut down Club trees threatening neighbors property—\$250. \$250 for purchase of new hot water heater approved. Bernard Genaud received estimate for repair and/or replacement of galley patio roof section.— **MEMBERS ARE INVITED TO GIVE THEIR OPINIONS ON FUTURE USE OF GALLEY, SO TRUSTEES CAN DECIDE ON IMPROVEMENTS/REPAIRS.** Virginia Conk reported on estimates for Clubhouse floor replacement, ballrm cabinet replacement at 10x10 (presently 10x20), replacing lower cabinets on sink wall incl. uniform height counter top, installing dishwasher & new refrigerator. Additionally Trustees requested estimates on replacing floor in restrms, restrm stall replacement, new furniture for Commodore's Room.

September 14, 1993

FINANCE Bid from Harry McGough, Jr. for accounting accepted. Dues billed to 167 families. Club continues to collect arrears Master Lease payments under its new get-tough lien program.

ANNUAL MEETING Date set at DEC. 3, 1993. By-laws change to reduced annual accounting fees will head agenda: **ARTICLE VIII, SEC 3A (4) Change sentence which reads. "Be responsible for the submission of, at the Primary Meeting of the Club, a detailed report of the financial condition of the club for the preceding fiscal year, which such report shall be AUDITED by the accountants designated by the Board of Trustees."**

NOMINATING In addition to Patti Owens, Ron Sorensen, Andy Bethune chosen by members, the Trustees have appointed Debi Ferguson, Steve Levinson, Joe Pilewski. The Trustees whose terms expire are Peter Garland, Robert Drummond, Virginia Conk.

CLUBHOUSE Trustee Conk submitted bids for entire floor, cabinets, refrigerator, dishwasher, furniture, plumbing for \$12,500. Nursery School parents will donate window treatment & painting. Trustees approved unanimously.

MAINTENANCE Trustee Miller suggested schedule of repair be set for docks on annual basis. Trustee Genaud will present galley roof estimates next mtg. Re-surfacing tennis court & installing water fountain tabled to next mtg. Cost of replacing banquet-style tables to be checked.
