



2012 Season Dock Rental Information Dock Slip Renewal Deadline: March 15th, 2012



As we get closer to the start of the boating season, we want to remind all members who rented slips in 2011 that the March 15th dock slip renewal deadline is approaching. We already have several new member dock slip rental requests and about twelve non-members who want to rent a slip from us this season.

The 2012 dock rental fee for members is \$450.00. If you plan on renewing for the upcoming season, please return the completed and signed rental agreement along with a copy of your boat registration and payment by March 15th 2012. Also, please indicate if there is any repair issue that you feel needs to be tended to regarding your slip. If you have no intention

to renew your dock slip for the 2012 season, please contact the club office so that we may reassign the slip to another member.

After March 18th, we will assign the new member rental slips and open up available slips to members who want to rent a second slip. On April 1st, all remaining open dock slips will be made available to non-members, with a member referral, at a rental fee of \$1,225. We also have several select dock slips available for rent at a discounted price. Members may rent those select slips for \$400 or non-members may rent them for \$1,025. Please contact the dock master for details on those select slips.



The \$1000.00 Lake Forest Yacht Club Scholarship Applications now being accepted!

Members may now apply for the 2012 LFYC Scholarship, which we will be awarding to one of our members who is a 2012 graduating senior. Applications are available on our website: www.lfyc.org or at your school guidance office. The deadline for submis-

sion for this scholarship is April 16th 2012.

The scholarship will award \$1,000 to help start off an applicant's higher education endeavor. This one time award may be used for tuition, books and other school related expenses. The candidate must be a Lake Forest Yacht Club member in good standing as well as a 2012 graduating high school senior. Each applicant will write an essay explaining why they are the ideal candidate to be the recipient of the LFYC Scholarship as well as provide three (3) letters of recommendation. Complete details of the application criteria will be found on the LFYC Scholarship.

Scholarship applications should be addressed to the LFYC Scholarship Committee and be mailed to the LFYC with a postage date no later than April 16th, 2012. The five members of the 2012 LFYC Scholarship Committee will evaluate all applications and make a decision on who will be the recipient of the 2012 LFYC Scholarship. The recipient will be notified on or before May 31st, 2012.

Saturday, May 14, 2011 Time: 8:30 am to 4:30 pm (approximately) Cost: \$65.00

Cost Includes textbook, a federal regulations booklet, safety brochures, as well as lunch and soft drinks. Students must bring: a ball point pen, a pencil, a current form of ID and a self-addressed stamped envelope to the course. In approximately 90 days, The Safe Boating Certificate Card will be mailed to the student in the self-addressed stamped envelope by The State

Police.

Trustee Meeting Minutes February 9, 2012

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 7:08 by Ray Calogero

MEETING ADJOURNED: 9:40 by Ray Calogero

For a full review of the minutes, please come down to the office.

Ray Calogero started off the meeting by discussing the LFYC Grant. He informed the board that there was a small change in the application/requirements which relates to the Lake Forest Yacht Club. You can read and print the application on the website for more details or contact the office. Ray let the board members know that he and Phil Schiff had a meeting with the Lake Forest Nursery School with regards to changes being made beginning 2012-2013 school year. Discussion ensued. Please contact the office for a full review of the meeting minutes regarding this topic.

BJ Caraccioli was next to present his reports. Discussion ensued regarding the installation of the extra security cameras. Plans have been made to have them installed next weekend. They will be on or near the office and be aimed at the office, gate entrance, B & C docks, etc. Warning signs are also being posted in the area. Al Rossy will be hired again this year to handle the club's security. The gate was removed for the winter so that the plow can get through to clear the road. It will be installed in the spring. A detailed discussion by the board took place after the meeting regarding the office restructuring and changes.

Jeff Dowd has taken the floor to go over and discuss the club's financials. Areas looked at were social, maintenance and docks. For a review of this information please stop in the office.

Keith Beaudoin was the next to speak and he informed the board that he has created a spreadsheet to keep things organized with regards to maintenance items. Discussion ensued regarding tracking the expenses. Keith informed the board that someone has contacted the office regarding the handyman/maintenance position. Keith placed a call to him and he is waiting for a response. Keith and Andy are working together to create a fixed format for the Porthole news. The idea is that eventually the office may be printing the issue and/or it will be posted on the website with faster downloading and easier page navigation. The board has agreed to hire the current landscaper again to handle this year's grounds maintenance.

Following Keith was Phil Schiff's report. He informed the board members that he and Ray were going to meet with Frank to have a discussion regarding the social committee. There was one change to the beach rules this year and that is smoking is not permitted on the beach. There will be designated areas for smoking. There will also be cans in that area to dispose a used cigarette. Discussion ensued regarding this year's beach staff. The office has begun to receive applications for lifeguard positions and each will be reviewed shortly. Discussion ensued regarding swim instructor, salaries, job duties,, etc. Discussion also ensued regarding the galley and how it will be run this year.

The next topic was lead by Rich L'Altrelli. He let everyone know that he is working on the swim team and the nursery school contracts. Discussion ensued on how the contact will be written as a main concern

is the club's liability exposures. Rich is going to reach out to the galley renovation committee to see where they are in the process. Insurance policies have been renewed.

Our meeting is almost at an end when it was Andy Egan's turn to present his report. He advises that he received some requests from members with regards to improvements to the tennis court. Andy took a look at the court. Andy is looking into costs for some repairs/ improvements and will report to the board. Andy is also going to take on repairs necessary to the wall ball court next to the clubhouse. He will look into costs for those repairs as well. The boat course has been set up and the office is now accepting enrollment. Please see details on it in this issue. Andy is reaching out to Jim Brown regarding some items of concern with regards to the swim team.

OLD BUSINESS: The board is still working on a decision with regards to the violations noted by the Fire Prevention Bureau. All of the violations were corrected with the exception of the stove/hood in the kitchen. The board is working with the town to get this matter resolved. Discussion ensued regarding the clubhouse rental agreement.
