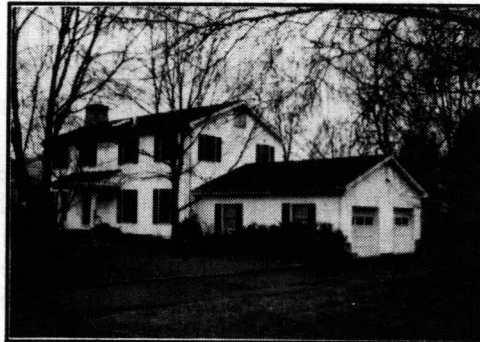

women planning pregnancy within one year, nursing mothers and children under 5 should not eat largemouth bass or chain pickerel more than once per month. High levels of mercury have been found in these species taken from Lk. Hopatcong.
